WFRC Regional Growth Committee Meeting was held at WFRC Office, 41 N Rio Grande Street, Salt Lake City and via Zoom.

1. Introductions & Consent Agenda

At 9:19a.m., Mayor Tamara Tran of Kaysville City, Chair of the Regional Growth Committee, called the meeting to order and welcomed the members and guests. Introductions were made both in person and online. **ACTION: [00:04:01]** Bountiful City Mayor Kate Bradshaw made a motion to approve the [minutes](#) of the RGC meeting held on May 21, 2026. Herriman City Mayor Lorin Palmer seconded the motion. There was no discussion and the minutes were approved unanimously.

2. Public Comment [00:04:22]

There was no public comment.

3. Chair Report [00:04:44]

a. How the [Wasatch Choice Vision](#) relates to transportation funding

Chair Tamara Tran shared her perspective on how she came to learn how WFRC's plans affect funding. She urged committee members to seek clarification from WFRC staff as needed. Ted Knowlton then offered a summary illustrating the link between the Wasatch Choice Vision and transportation funding.

Meg Padjen delivered a brief overview detailing the financial and technical assistance programs available through WFRC, including deadlines for each program.

c. [2026 Wasatch Choice Vision Fall Workshops](#) [00:11:54]

Samantha DeSeelhorst presented the scheduled Wasatch Choice Vision workshops for this coming October/November. She highlighted the specific regions and dates for these events and requested that any individuals who had not yet been formally invited contact staff for further information.

4. [ACTION: Release Amendment #5 to the 2023-2050 Regional Transportation Plan for Public Comment](#) [00:18:07]

Jory Johner, Long Range Planning Director at the Wasatch Front Regional Council, provided an overview of the amendment process for the Regional Transportation Plan, outlining the various levels of amendments and their respective criteria. He explained that Amendment #5 includes a Level 3 project amendment and discussed the potential impacts of the project, along with the technical considerations necessary to incorporate these changes, and next steps for amendment #5. **ACTION: [00:38:01]** Fruit Heights City Mayor Jeanne Groberg made a motion to release the projects within Amendment #5 to the 2023-2050 RTP and the air quality conformity analysis as found in the Draft Air Quality Memorandum 44 to a 30-day public comment period. Morgan County Commissioner Blaine Fackrell seconded the motion. With no discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

5. [DISCUSSION: Transportation's Secret Weapon: Jobs/Housing Balance](#) [00:39:21]

WFRC Executive Director Andrew Gruber and Analytics Deputy Director Bill Hereth facilitated a conversation regarding how enhancing the balance between jobs and housing in communities can strengthen the regional transportation network. Bill Hereth demonstrated the newly launched [Utah Commuter Flow Web Map](#), designed to illustrate the volume of residents commuting outside their local area for work and its broader impact on the Wasatch Front transportation system. Committee members evaluated potential strategies for local governments to improve job-housing alignment, alongside the key challenges associated with achieving this balance.
