Town Hall

Mayor Jenkins invited the Historical Society Secretary Bradley Winger to talk about what is happening at the Museum. Bradley will be attending a conference on curation and how to curate museums. They are currently working on new exhibits for the museum and moved the life exhibit into the Old City Hall. The Old City Hall will become more of the daily life of Eureka, and the depot will become more mining oriented. The auction for the Jubilee is ready. Mayor Jenkins said Doug Meadows has talked to him about donating the Chief mining site to the city. Spens Hansen said he would be interested in donating lumber to erect the Gemini Headframe. Mayor Jenkins spoke to the County Recorder, and the Bullion Beck Headframe is within city boundaries. He would like to work with the Historical Society and the State to keep it up and get cameras on it. He is still planning on having his Town Hall meeting at the end of the month.
