Presentation:

Building a Statewide Type 1 Hazardous Materials Response Capability

Presenters:

- Bryan Case, Retired Division Chief, Unified Fire Authority
- Kathryn McMullin, Emergency Manager, Summit County

Chief Case and Ms. McMullin presented on efforts to establish a statewide Type 1 Hazardous Materials Response Team capability in Utah. The presentation focused on current HazMat response capabilities, identified statewide gaps, and proposed solutions for creating a sustainable statewide response system.

Key topics:

- **Utah currently lacks a dedicated statewide Type 1 HazMat response capability.**
- **Increasing hazardous materials transportation, population growth, critical infrastructure development, and future events such as the Olympics are creating additional response challenges.**
- **A proposed statewide model would utilize personnel and resources from multiple jurisdictions, similar to existing statewide specialty response teams.**
- **Funding concepts being explored include transportation impact fees, Tier II reporting fees, and other industry-supported funding mechanisms.**

- **A statewide working group is being formed to evaluate governance, funding, and operational considerations for a future Type 1 team.**
