Mayor Painter stated that the Special Meeting was called to discuss and finalize the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for procuring a CPA firm to perform Mona City's financial services. The bids had previously been opened and discussion started at the work session on August 12, 2026, but due to lack of time, the Council was unable to make a final decision.

A scoring sheet with five evaluation categories was distributed, and each CPA firm was scored in every category. Each Councilmember completed their scores and submitted them to the Mayor for tallying. The resulting firm rankings were reviewed as circulated, and the Council voted to begin negotiations with the top-ranked firm. If negotiations are unsuccessful, the City will proceed to the second-ranked firm.
