1. **Approval of March 4, 2026 Minutes**– Motion by Geneva Woodmansee, seconded by Jason Wiggins, to approve the minutes. Motion passed unanimously.
 2. **Hidden Canyon Park Concept Plan** – Brad Jensen reviewed a concept plan for the future development of the Hidden Canyon Park. Motion by Nate Crowther to support the concept plan with the following recommendations 1. Add restroom, 2. Simplify or eliminate the Fit Stations, 3. Add trees to the plan. Seconded by Doug Ovard. Motion passed unanimously.
 3. **River to Range Trail Connection Plan Draft** – Brad Jensen reviewed the draft of the River to Range Trail Connection Plan. Motion by Jamie Pogue, seconded by Geneva Woodmansee, to recommend the “Northern Corridor” as presented in the plan, with adding a potential trail connection between the northern corridor and the Point Development. Motion passed unanimously.
 4. **Committee/Staff reports**

Brad Jensen provided an update on the construction of Jensen Farm Park. Project anticipated to be completed by end of June.

Jason Wiggins discussed the popularity of the River Bottoms Disc Golf Course and the opportunity to do volunteer work on the course.

Committee members discussed various primitive trail issues, including jumps at the bottom of Zooropa Trail, erosion issue on Achtung Baby, and the need for more durable and additional wind socks on Levitate Trail.
