**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF TAYLORSVILLE
CITY, UTAH, ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE BJA EDWARD
BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT**

WHEREAS, Taylorsville City has received a charitable donation in the amount of Fifteen Thousand, one hundred and fifty-three dollars (\$15,153.00) from the BJA Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant for the BJA FY25; and

WHEREAS, TAYLORSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE § 2. 32. 180 provides that any grant that anticipates or proposes to bind the City to a particular project or contract shall be submitted to the Council for approval prior to accepting the grant; and

WHEREAS, BJA funds support states and communities with direct funds to support the Taylorsville Police Department with ballistic vests; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to formally accept this grant on behalf of the residents of Taylorsville City. The City has received notice that the BJA Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Program has approved the City's application for funding in the amount of \$15,153.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Taylorsville City Council hereby accepts the \$ 15,153.00 grant for the above- stated purpose and directs the City Administrator to include this amount in the 2025- 2026 Mid-Year or Year-End Budget Adjustments, increasing both revenue and corresponding expenditure lines. This Resolution, assigned Resolution No. 26-25, shall take effect immediately upon passage and acceptance as provided herein
