To receive public input regarding the City of South Salt Lake proposed increase to property tax revenue.

The SOUTH SALT LAKE CITY tax on a \$470,000 residence would increase from \$644.44 to \$727.94, which is \$83.50 per year.

The SOUTH SALT LAKE CITY tax on a \$470,000 business would increase from \$1,171.71 to \$1,323.52, which is \$151.81 per year.

If the proposed budget is approved, SOUTH SALT LAKE CITY would receive an additional \$1,839,537 in property tax revenue per year as a result of the tax increase.

If the proposed budget is approved, SOUTH SALT LAKE CITY would increase its property tax budgeted revenue by 12.99% above last year's property tax budgeted revenue excluding eligible new growth.

Public Hearing

To receive public input regarding the City of South Salt Lake proposed increase to property tax revenue.

Stewart Okobia, Finance Director, stated that the City of South Salt Lake was proposing to increase its property tax revenue. He explained the financial impact on residents and businesses. For the average resident, the tax would increase from approximately \$644 to \$727, representing an increase of about \$83.50 per year, or roughly \$7 per month. For an average business in the City, the tax would increase from approximately \$1,171 to \$1,323.52, which is an increase of about \$151.81 per year, or roughly \$13 per month.

Mr. Okobia further noted that if the proposed budget were approved, the City would receive an additional \$1,839,537 in property tax revenue for the year. This would represent an approximate 12% budget increase from the prior year's property tax receipts.

Following the presentation, Mayor Wood clarified that the proposed tax increase, representing a 12% increase, was specific to public safety. She stated that it was the public safety tax line

item on property taxes and that all of those funds could only be expended for public safety purposes. Council Chair Bynum thanked Mayor Wood for the clarification.

The public hearing was opened at 7:08 p.m.

There were no public comments from any of the attendees, in person and online.

The public hearing was closed at 7:08 p.m.

City Attorney, Josh Collins, noted that copies of the property tax impact schedule had been available at every public meeting since June and were available at the current meeting. He also advised the Council to be careful when making their motions, specifically regarding the tax rate, to ensure they were moving for the correct item and speaking clearly for the public record.

There were no further comments or questions from the Council Members.

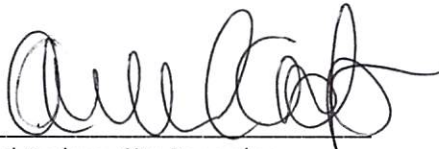

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-27

AN ORDINANCE OF THE SOUTH SALT LAKE CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING A FINAL TAX RATE FOR THE PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICES PURPOSES OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. Section 59-2-912, on or before June 22 of each year the City of South Salt Lake (the "City") must adopt a proposed tax rate, or a final tax rate if it does not exceed the certified tax rate;

WHEREAS, Utah Code Ann. Section 10-6-133 requires the governing body of each City to set the real and personal property tax levy for various municipal purposes before June 22;

WHEREAS, the City shall determine the requirements for each fund for which property taxes are to be levied and shall specify in an ordinance or resolution adopting the levy the amount apportioned to each fund;

WHEREAS, the proceeds of the levy apportioned for special fund purposes shall be credited to the appropriate accounts in the applicable special funds;

WHEREAS, the Council created the public safety service levy in 2022 for the purpose of providing a dedicated funding source for public safety services in the City and created the public safety service special revenue fund for the purposes of holding revenues collected therefrom;

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2026, the City adopted a proposed tax rate of .001397 for public safety purposes because that rate exceeds the certified tax rate;

WHEREAS, on August 11, 2026, the City held a duly noticed public hearing as part of the truth in taxation requirement and adopted a final budget consistent with state law on August 11, 2026;

WHEREAS, for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2027, the City intends to adopt a final tax rate of .001397 for public safety purposes of the City, which exceeds the certified tax rate; and

WHEREAS, the City has considered the impact this ordinance may have on the health, safety, and welfare of the City and the impact this ordinance may have on family health, stability, and formation and finds that this ordinance is in the best interest of the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of South Salt Lake as follows:

SECTION I: The City hereby adopts the final tax rate of .001397 and sets that rate as the final tax rate for the public safety services of the City, which funds shall be held in the public safety services special revenue fund which results in a levy amount of \$7,952,044 to be used for public safety services.

SECTION II: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION III: Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon Mayor's signature and publication, or after fifteen days of transmission to the office of the Mayor if neither approved nor disapproved by the Mayor, and thereafter, publication.

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2026, following a public hearing noticed and held in accordance with Utah Code § 10-6-111(3), the Council reviewed, considered, and tentatively adopted each fund of the City's Tentative Budget, including the Tentative General Fund budget, which was officially placed in the City Recorder's office for inspection by the general public;

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public hearing on the adoption of the tentative budget as the interim budget for Fiscal Year July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2027, was held on June 10, 2026, as prescribed by The Uniform Fiscal Procedures Act for Utah Cities;

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2026, the Council adopted the certified tax rate for the general purposes of the City but adopted a proposed tax rate for the public safety service levy that exceeds the certified tax rate;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of South Salt Lake as follows:

SECTION I: The Interim General Fund Budget attached hereto, incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby appropriated for the corporate purposes and objects of the City for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027, and is hereby adopted as the "Final Budget for the General Fund of the City of South Salt Lake, Utah for the Fiscal Year 2026-2027" (the "Budget").

SECTION II: The Interim General Fund Budget for Fiscal Year July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2027, shall be the Final Budget for the General Fund of the City of South Salt Lake for Fiscal Year July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2027.

SECTION III: Pursuant to Utah Code § 10-6-118, a copy of the Budget for each fund within the Budget, including the General Fund Budget, shall be certified by the Budget Officer and it is hereby directed that the Budget be filed with the State Auditor within 30 days after adoption and with the Office of the City Recorder and shall be available to the public in accordance with the law.

SECTION IV: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION V: Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon Mayor's signature and publication, or after fifteen days of transmission to the office of the Mayor if neither approved nor disapproved by the Mayor, and thereafter, publication.
