Recommended Action:

That the Committee continue and repeal R277-922, Digital Teaching and Learning, on first reading and forward to the Board for continuation and approval on second and final reading.

Purpose of Memo:

5-year review

Background:**Background**

During the 2026 General Session, the Legislature passed S.B. 2, Public Education Budget Amendments, which eliminated funding for the Digital Teaching and Learning Grant Program and repealed Utah Code Section 53F-2-510. R277-922 establishes requirements for the administration of the Digital Teaching and Learning Grant Program and is no longer necessary.

The Office of Administrative Rules (OAR) procedures disfavor allowing a rule to expire. Accordingly, staff requests that the Committee first recommend continuation of R277-922 and then recommend repeal of the rule.

Summary of Proposed Changes

The proposed change repeals R277-922 in its entirety because the Digital Teaching and Learning Grant Program is no longer funded and its authorizing statute has been repealed.
