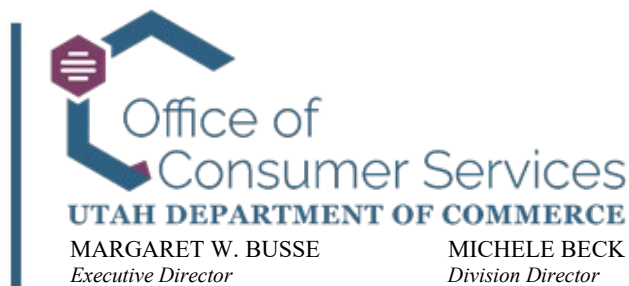

1. Welcome & Business
