Item #1: The Salt Lake County Health Department is proposing amendments to the Health Regulation #22, *Vehicle Emissions Control Program*.

Action for the Board: We are asking the Board to hold a public hearing for Health Regulation #22.

Summary of Changes

The Vehicle Emission Control Program regulation is proposed with the following revisions:

- Changed “shall mean” to “means” in all definitions of Section 2.
- General formatting and numbering corrected throughout Regulation.
- Amended references throughout Regulation to reflect correct sections and codes.
- Added, Removed, and Amended definitions to match regulation.
- Removed Heavy Duty Diesel powered vehicles from I/M program compliance requirements.
- Added initial test requirements for recalled vehicles to Compliance Assurance List.
- Removed some tool requirements as part of I/M Station permitting requirements.
- Remove free re-inspection requirements for exempt TSI vehicles.
- Removed TSI requirements
- Added technician renewal applicant may be required to take renewal course prior to expiration of Certificate of Qualification.
- Added and amended Certificate of Qualification KSAs.
- Added allowances for SLCoHD to issue VECI label and letter to allow vehicle inspection at any permitted I/M station.
- Amended language for Negotiated Consent Agreements in Appendix B.
- Removed Appendix C & D
