A PROCLAMATION COMMEMORATING SEPTEMBER 17-23, 2026
AS CONSTITUTION WEEK IN THE TOWN OF SPRINGDALE**

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the United States of America stands as a testament to the tenacity of Americans throughout history to maintain our liberties, freedoms, and inalienable rights; and

WHEREAS, September 17, 2026, marks the 239th anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention, thus outlining the fundamental principles by which our nation is governed; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17th through the 23rd as Constitution Week;

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Council hereby proclaims the week of September 17-23, 2026, as

Constitution Week

in Springdale, Utah and urges our citizens to reaffirm the ideals the framers of the Constitution had in 1787 by vigilantly protecting the freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our liberties, remembering that lost rights may never be regained, and to reflect on the privilege of being an American with all the rights and responsibilities it affords.
