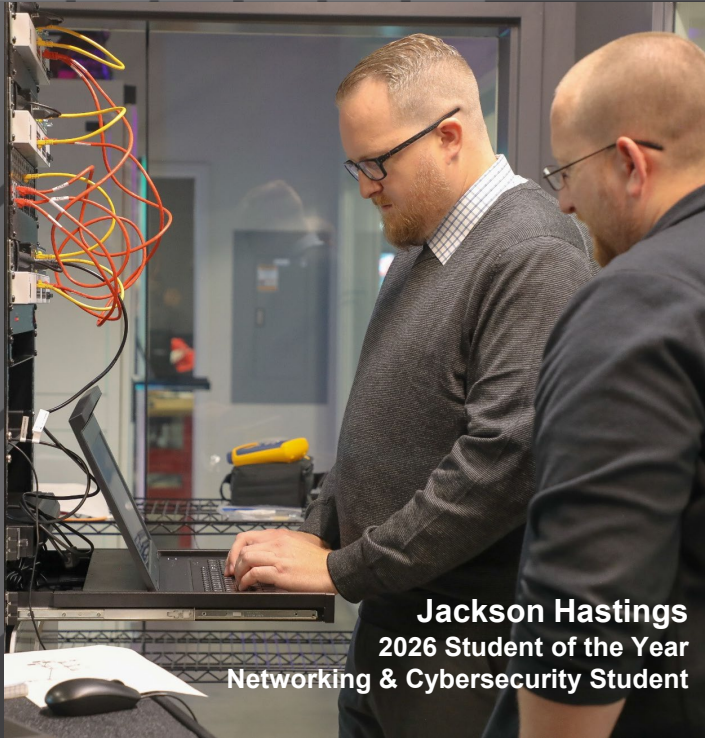

Our experienced **instructors come from industry** and work with local companies to stay current on the newest technologies. Their primary focus is the **success of every student**.



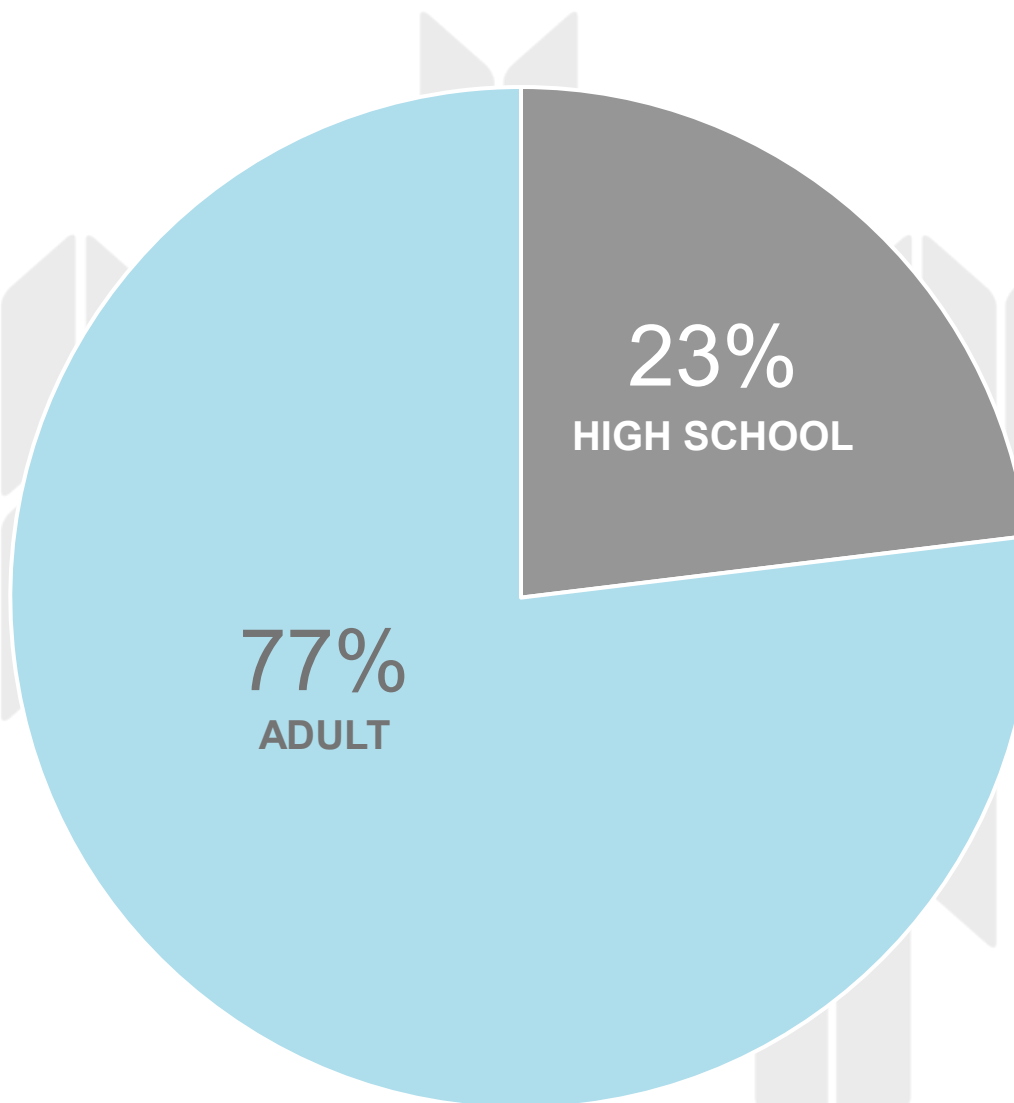

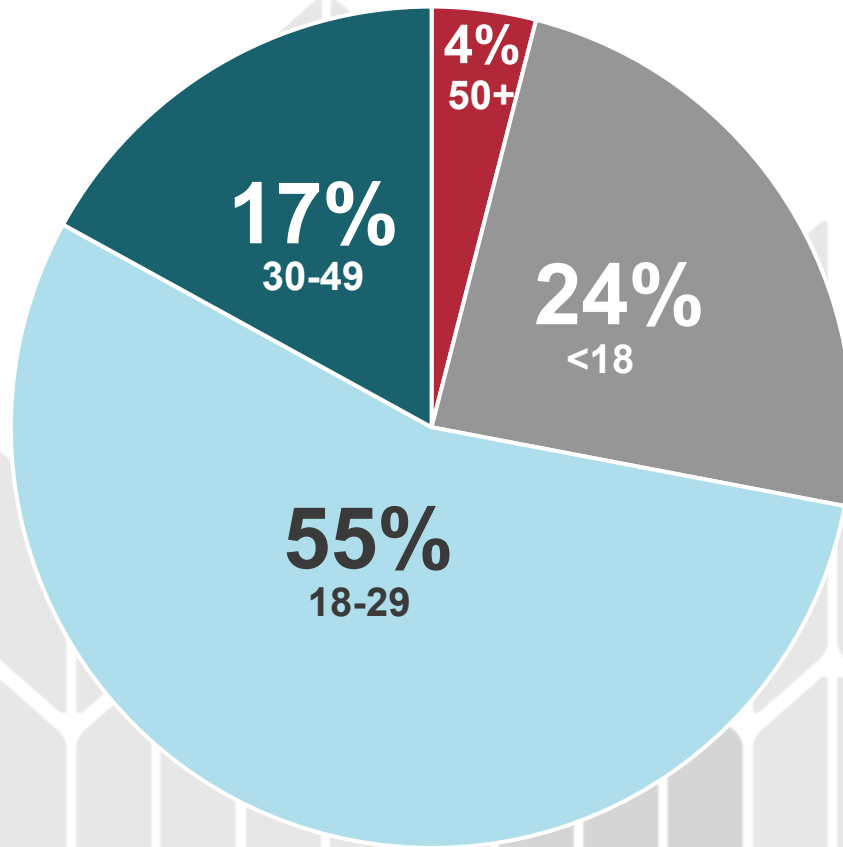

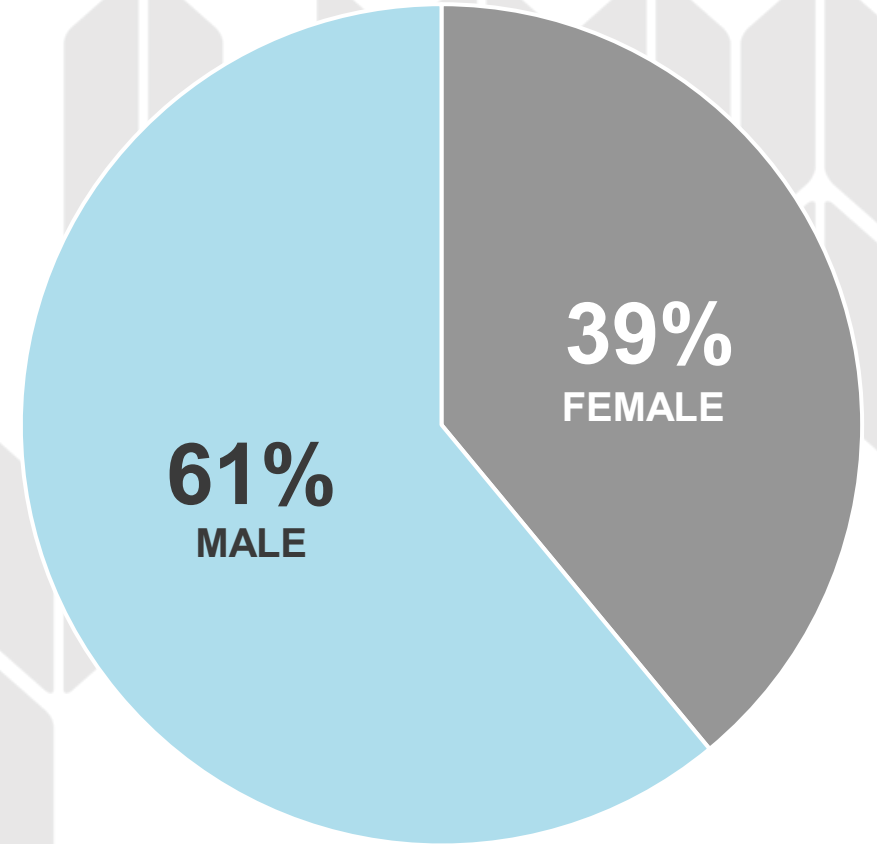


OUR STUDENTS FY 2026

Average Student Age **25** Years



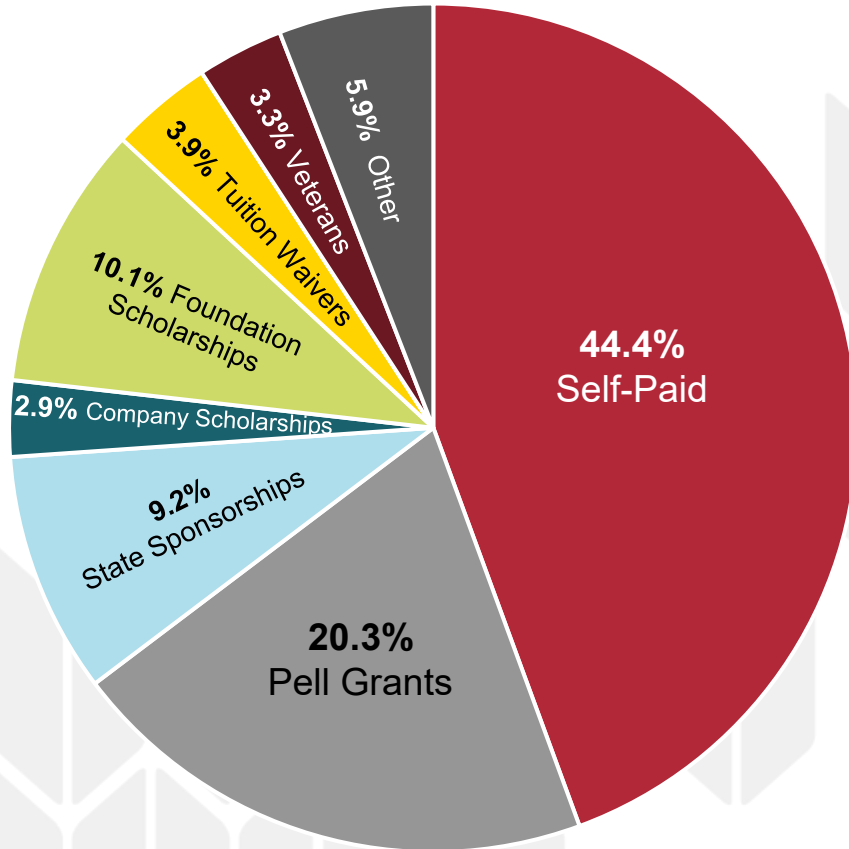

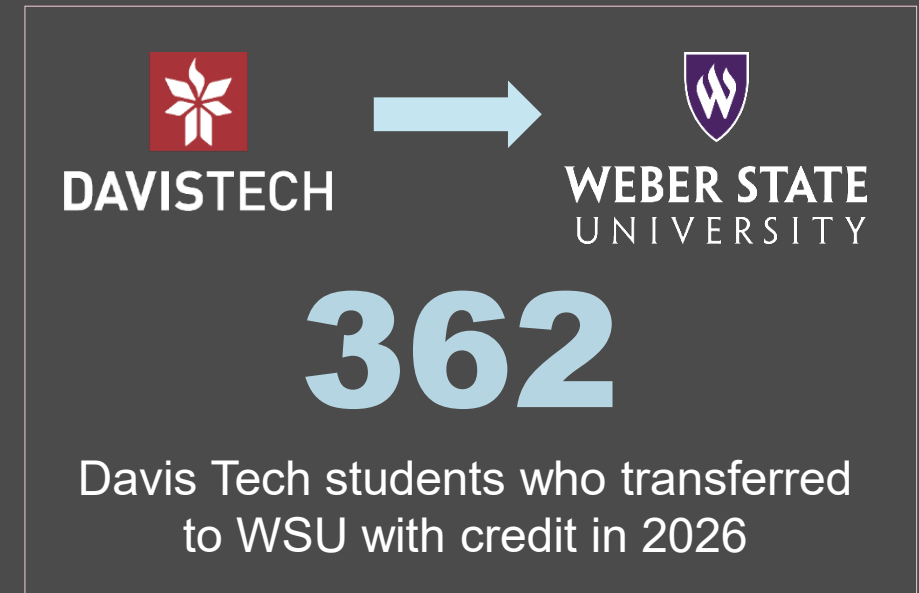

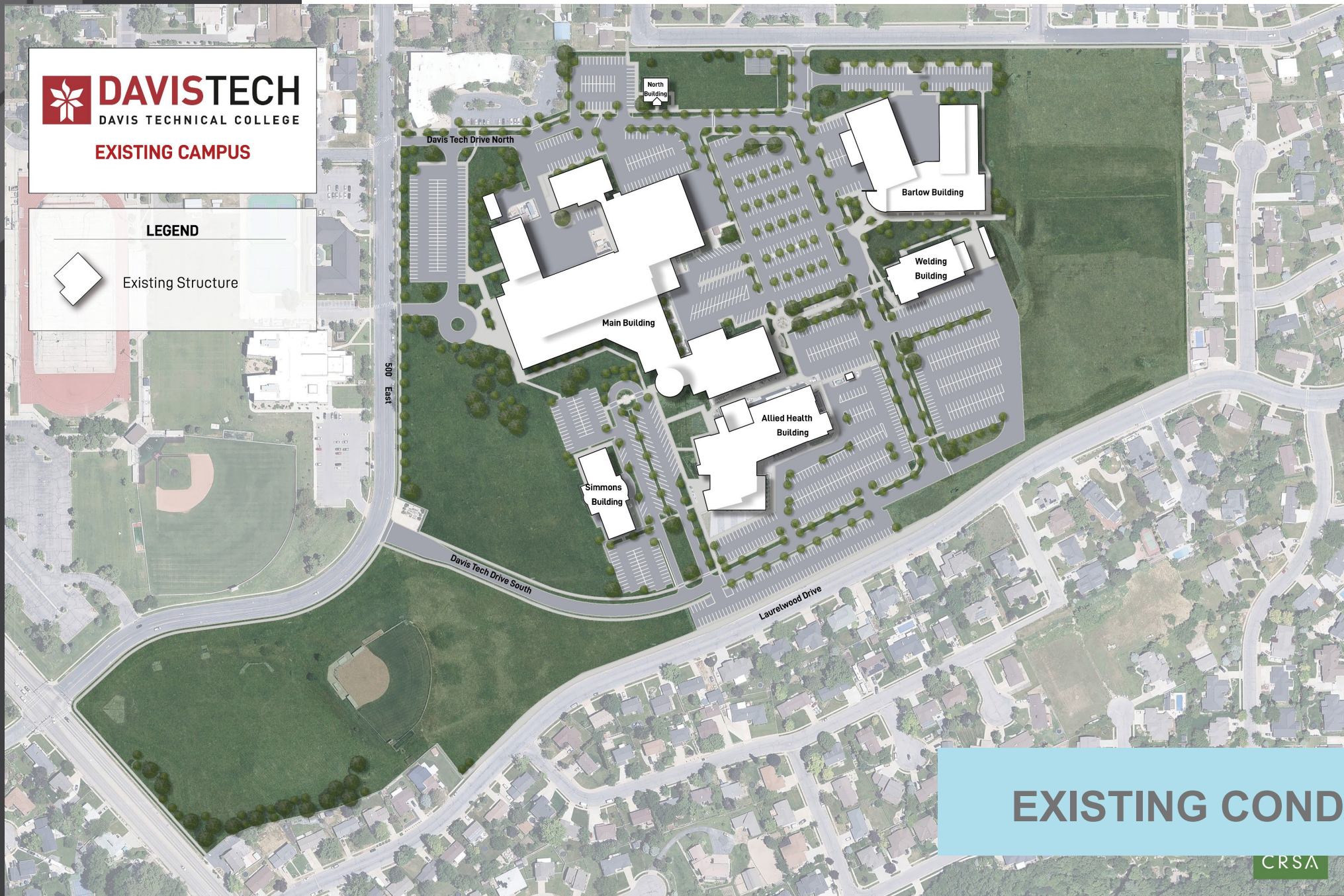

PROPOSED MASTER PLAN UPDATE

Acquisition of the Canyon Heights Building from the Davis School District when the current lease expires in 2048, or sooner.

Widening the northwest entrance

Replace the Automation Lab and Grounds Shed with a new 17,800 sq. ft., two-story instructional building



Reconstruct and expand the North Building to approximately 10,500 sq. Ft.

Add a pickleball court adjacent to the existing sports court.

PROPOSED MASTER PLAN UPDATE



Construct a 12,900 sq. ft. Facilities Building & Grounds Complex

Construct a 48,800 sq. ft. Instructional building

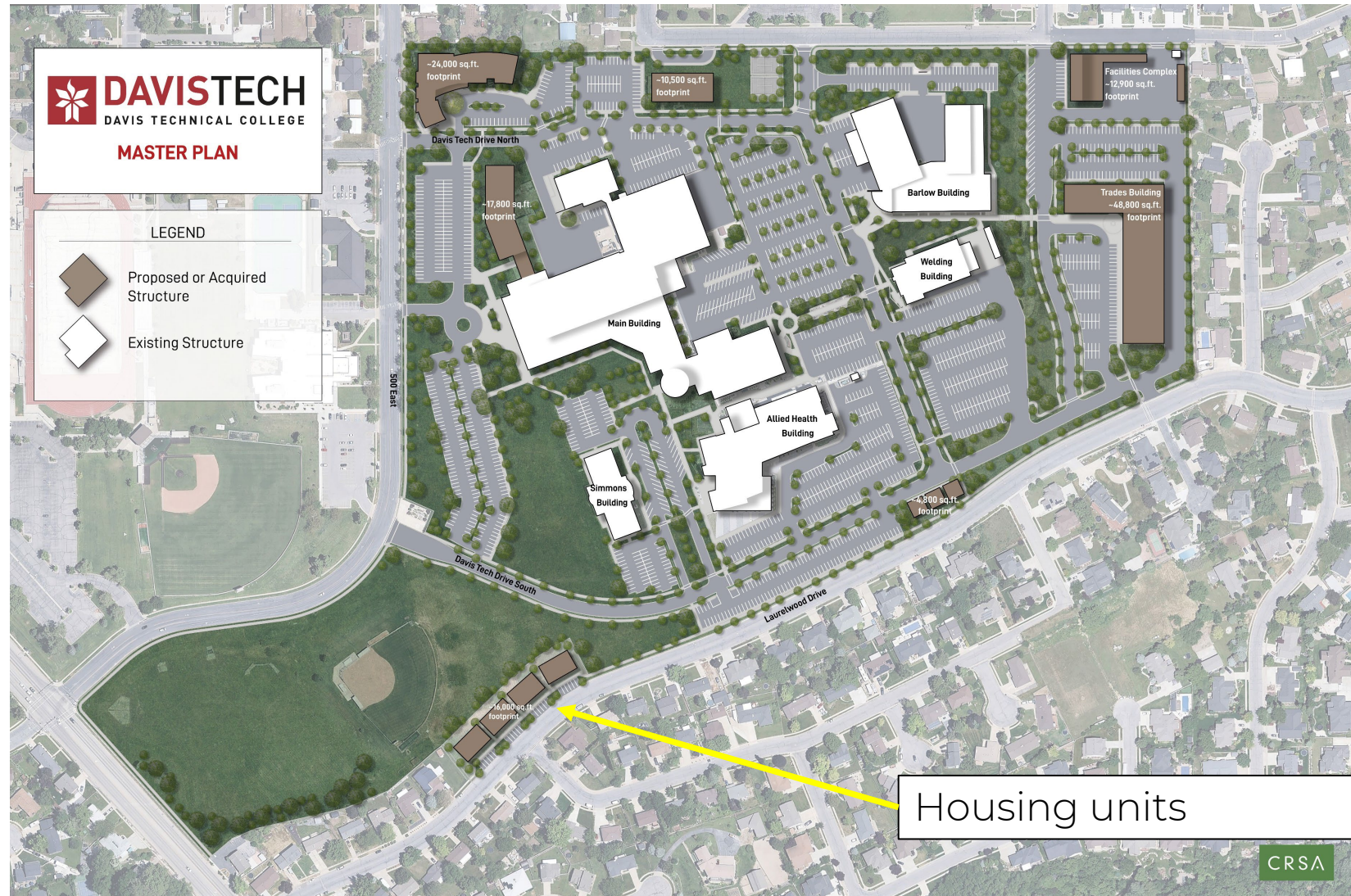
Open a Laurelwood Drive connection

Add portable classrooms or small buildings on the South campus boundary.
