I would like to add my comments about item D3. I support nighttime work, but feel during this peak tourist season of the fall, disrupting the natural quietude which sets upon Springdale around 9pm is a huge compromise. They can do as much night construction as they want and have minimum impacts during the months of Nov-February, as well as have least interference with tourist traffic at that time as well.
