NOTICE OF PROJECT AREA PLAN AMENDMENT**

Notice is hereby given that the Utah Inland Port Authority Board (UIPA), acting pursuant to 11-58-501 Utah Code Annotated, approved the following resolution amending the Skyline Corridor project area with an effective date of September 3, 2026.

**UTAH INLAND PORT AUTHORITY RESOLUTION 2026-42
A RESOLUTION OF THE UTAH INLAND PORT AUTHORITY BOARD
ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE SKYLINE CORRIDOR INLAND PORT PROJECT AREA PLAN**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code §11-58-301(1) as amended (“UCA”), the Utah Inland Port Authority (“Authority”) is “governed by a board which shall manage and conduct the business and affairs of the Authority”; and

WHEREAS, the Authority created a project area known as the Skyline Corridor to facilitate and fund regional economic development opportunities and maximize the long-term economic benefit of the region; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to UCA §11-58-504, the Authority may amend a project area plan; and

WHEREAS, the Authority board desires to amend the Skyline Corridor Project Area, which was originally adopted on October 7, 2024 and adopt an updated project area plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY BOARD as follows:

1. The Authority board has found and determined that the attached amendment to the Skyline Corridor project area plan meets the statutory requirements set forth in UCA § 11-58-501(3) and includes:
 - a. the legal description of the boundary of the project area,
 - b. the purpose and intent with respect to the project area and the board’s finding and determination that:
 - i. there is a need to effectuate a public purpose;
 - ii. there is a public benefit to the proposed Skyline Corridor project;
 - iii. it is economically sound and feasible to adopt and carry out the Skyline Corridor project area plan; and
 - iv. carrying out the Skyline Corridor project area plan will promote the goals and objectives stated in Subsection 11-58-203(1).
2. The Authority board hereby adopts the amendment of the Skyline Corridor Project and accepts the boundary changes and the updated budget.
3. This Resolution is effective September 3, 2026, upon the affirmative vote of the Authority Board.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Authority Board this 3rd day of September, 2026.
