August 10th, 2026. 7:00 p.m.

Call to Order: 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Levanger.

Roll Call: Meliss Holloway, Brad Peacock, Jim Levanger, Ralph Brinkerhoff (Absent) Kim Erkkila, Debbie Redford.

Moment of Reflection:

Pledge of Allegiance: Led by Mayor Levanger

Minutes Review: There were no questions on the minutes from July 13, 2026. All were approved.

Financial Adjustments Reports: Mayor Jim Levanger read the financial report. There was a \$30.00 adjustment for Robert Jacobsen. This was dismissed.

Bills to Pay: Brad Peacock questioned the bills for Forefront General for the Well Vault. The mayor advised that we pay it and then they reimburse the town. Brad Peacock made a motion to pay the bills. Meliss Holloway seconded it. All were in favor.

Public Comment Period: Starr Dowding 235 No. Meriden Street. Asked why Laurel Street is just going to be paved.

Joe Lamper 20 No. Church St. Does the town get any more money from the CIB?

Town Updates: OutLaw Car Show will be September 5th, 2026.

Well Vault project is still in limbo as they are waiting for Made in American parts to arrive. And Rocky Mountain Power had the town upgrade the power at the well vault at a cost of approx. \$3,600.00. That will be charged to the well vault project.

New Business: When to start per diem for Dale Lea for winter months for lot rent and propane.

Brad Peacock would like to see the financials for the sewer trucks/hauler. Brad would like to look at the repairs for the trucks, labor, fuel, and per diem for lot rent and propane. This was tabled until September 14th, 2026. Kim Erikkla made a motion to pay the lot rent for September. Meliss Holloway seconded it. Mayor polled the council. Meliss Holloway "I", Brad Peacock "I", Kim Erikkla "I". The town clerk will make a spreadsheet showing the income and expenses for the sewer haul for September 14th, 2026 council meeting. Discussion and possible approval of culvert on Front Street. This may be a safety issue. Kim Erikkla made a motion to buy and fix the culvert on Front Street. Brad Peacock 2nd it. All were in favor.

Old Business: Discussion of possible additional awning at the park. Brad Peacock requested that the town put an ad in the newspaper requesting bids and contact companies for bids.

Possible Approval of more money from Pleasant Valley Days for School Roof. A discussion ensued and it was stated that the money to pay for the School Roof stays the same as previously approved. 1/3 from General Fund, 1/3 from Pleasant Valley Days and 1/3 from the School Restoration Fund. A total of \$29,125.50.

Discussion of possible approval for road improvements on Laurel Street. The town two bids that were received regarding Laurel Street Road improvement. Mayor stated that we need to get more detailed bids for September 2026 meeting.

Motion to adjourn made by Kim Erikkla. Meliss Holloway seconded it. All were in favor.
