1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Godfrey called the Clarkston Town Council to order at 7:00 p.m.
Mayor Godfrey led the Pledge of Allegiance and offered Reverence to begin the meeting.

2. NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Godfrey addressed the minutes of the Clarkston Town Council Meeting held February 17, 2015. Councilmember A. Godfrey motioned for the Clarkston Town Council to approve and adopt the minutes of February 17, 2015. Councilmember S. Palmer seconded the motion. All in favor "Aye". Motion carried

Resolution 15-05 "A Resolution Amending Zoning Ordinance Title 10 Chapter 1 Section 6 – Definitions"- Mayor Godfrey asked if there was any discussion by the Council prior to passing the resolution. There was no discussion so Mayor Godfrey read the resolution and asked for a motion to adopt Resolution 15-05. Councilmember R. Calderwood motioned for the Council to approve Resolution 15-05. Councilmember A. Godfrey seconded the motion. All in favor "Aye". Motion carried

Child and Family Support Center- The spokesperson for the Child and Family Support Center did not show up to the meeting. April is nationally recognized as Child Abuse Prevention month. This month brings awareness to the community that abuse happens here in Cache Valley and that through support and education abuse can be prevented. Each year the Child and Family Support Center asks cities and towns to adopt a Child Abuse Prevention Month Proclamation in support of this effort. Mayor Godfrey asked

Councilmember A. Godfrey to read the Child Abuse Prevention Month Proclamation to the Council and citizens present. Mayor Godfrey signed the Child Abuse Prevention Month Proclamation. See Attachment A

Cache County Sheriff Chad Jensen – Law Enforcement and Animal Control Contracts – Cache County Sheriff Chad Jensen was not able to attend the meeting as planned due to a family medical emergency. Sheriff Jensen will attend the April 21, 2015 Town Council Meeting to discuss the Clarkston Town Law Enforcement and Animal Control Contracts for Fiscal Year 2016.

National Day of Prayer – Mayor Godfrey informed the Council that the first National Day of Prayer was proclaimed by the Continental Congress in 1775. At the conclusion of the Revolutionary War it ended but was reinstated as an annual observance by members of Congress in 1952. Mayor Godfrey stated that this year's Annual National Day of Prayer is May 7, 2015. Mayor Godfrey proposed adopting a Declaration in support of National Prayer Day. Mayor Godfrey read the National Prayer Day Declaration to the Council and citizens present. Councilmember A. Godfrey motioned for the Council to approve the National Prayer Day Declaration. Resolution 15-05. Councilmember R. Calderwood seconded the motion. All in favor "Aye". Mayor Godfrey signed the National Prayer Day Declaration. See Attachment B

3. DEPARTMENTS

Mayor Godfrey – Community Center Rental – Town Employees – The Council discussed offering a discounted Community Center Rental Fee to town employees and elected officials. The Council determined that town employees, elected officials, the Fire Chief, and Assistant Fire Chief will be allowed one 50 % discounted rental fee per year. The discount will be \$15 for three hours, \$25 for three-five hours, and \$50 for five-eight hours.

Town Clean-Up Day – The Town Clean-Up Day will be held May 16, 2015. In case of inclement weather, a backup day will be May 30, 2013.

Councilmember A. Godfrey - Warrant List- Councilmember A. Godfrey presented the Warrant List for February 2015. Councilmember R. Calderwood motioned for the Clarkston Town Council to approve the warrant list as read. Councilmember A. Godfrey seconded the motion. All in favor "Aye"

Animal Control – Councilmember A. Godfrey stated that Christina Atkinson is preparing a Delinquent Dog License List. The list will be given to the Animal Control Officer for citations to be issued.

Martin Harris Pageant –Councilmember A. Godfrey reported that Lynn and Dorothy Page backed out of being Chair Persons of the Martin Harris Pageant Dinner. Councilmember A. Godfrey stated that she asked Julyenne Thomas and Tiffany Goodey if

they would Chair the dinner and they both agreed to be Chair Persons over the Martin Harris Pageant Dinner this year.

Councilmember R. Calderwood – Water Department – Councilmember R. Calderwood stated that Bryan Goodsell, Clarkston Town Water Operator, and himself will be meeting with Scott Archibald from Sunrise Engineering to discuss updating the Clarkston Town Water Master Plan.

Councilmember S. Palmer – Easter Egg Hunt - The Easter Egg Hunt will be Saturday April 4, 2015 at 9:00 am. The Youth Council will be organizing this event. The Town Clerk will post flyers, advertising the Easter Egg Hunt, in the Town Hall and Post Office. The Youth Council will also distribute small flyers to each house in Clarkston.


