#### Welcome:

- Carrie welcomed everyone present, and introductions were made.

#### Approval of November Minutes:

- **Motion:** George motioned to approve the minutes.
  - Ann seconded the motion.
  - All present were in favor of the approval.

#### Fund Update:

- The legislative report has been updated and posted on the website.

#### Legislative Update:

- Joyce is still trying to set up a meeting with Rep. Ray.
- Joyce will keep us updated throughout the session as to when committee members can help.
- Trisha is working on numbers of how many we can serve with the fund, and get that to Joyce.
- We are asking for \$200,000 of on-going funding.
- George has been getting ready for the session by finding about 30 people that have benefited from the fund to meet with their legislator's about the fund.
- Joyce emailed Dr. Patton to let him know that Rep. Ray is going to carry this bill, and that they are asking for \$200,000 on-going funding.
- George shared with the committee that there is going to be a primary seatbelt law that we all should support.

- Vocational Rehab (VR) is creating a waiting list beginning in March or April.
  - They will prioritize who they see first.
    - Their priorities are students (16-24 years old) and people with significant disabilities, etc.
    - This will affect BIAU and Phoenix Services, because they refer a lot of people to the VR.
      - The people they serve will be in the lower priorities for the VR, so they may not see any of their referrals.
  - The VR is going to be seeking more funding in this legislative session.
    - George expressed that we should support their Bill in hopes that the added funding will help with them seeing those that we refer to them.

#### Training Updates:

- BIAU:
  - From September to December 2014 – approximately 350+ people were trained at the Mexican Consulate.
  - Copper View Recreation Center – 25 people were trained.
  - Working with SLCHD on Recreational Programs and Coaches trained on Brain Injury.
- Phoenix Services:
  - October – Granite School District Special Education training (about 50 people attended).
  - December – Family Group Training with TBI 101.
  - February – Two CBIS trainings scheduled.
  - Working with SLCHD on Recreational Programs and Coaches trained on Brain Injury.

#### Other Items:

- The ILC Contracts are still in process.
  - The Departments contract process has some glitches.
- Carrie and George have both submitted the first quarter of their reports into Catalyst.
  - **TASK:** Brittany is going to look at it to make sure everything is okay.
- **REPORT:** Carrie did talk to Kris about the other ILC's that did not apply for the fund.
  - **TASK:** Carrie to follow-up to make sure that Kris talked to them and let Trisha know the outcome.
