

Craig Call is an attorney with Anderson Call & Wilkinson in Salt Lake City and Executive Director of the Utah Land Use Institute. He was the Private Property Rights Ombudsman for the State of Utah from 1997-2007 where he assisted in the mediation and arbitration of several thousand land-related disputes. He has been a real estate broker, general contractor and attorney. Craig served four years in the Utah Legislature and on the City Council in Provo. He authored The Utah Citizen's Guide to Land Use Regulation (2005), the comprehensive Utah Law of Eminent Domain (2008), and jointly authored the Utah Land Use Regulation Guidebook and the Utah Impact Fee Handbook and Checklists. He has lectured widely on land use regulation, eminent domain, property rights and dispute resolution in the U.S., as well as in Canada and the Peoples Republic of China. Craig is also an adjunct instructor at the University of Utah, and an Administrative Law Judge for the City of South Salt Lake, and a Land Use Appeals Hearing Officer for Salt Lake City, Riverdale, West Haven and South Ogden. He is an Impact Fee Hearing Officer for Salt Lake City as well.
