Dear Dr. Farmer:

In accordance with the regulations of the U.S. Department of Education, attached is a summary of actions taken by the ACEN Board of Commissioners during its meeting on March 12-13, 2015. The list of Commission actions is published on the ACEN website.

Initial accreditation is granted for five years when a program meets all ACEN Accreditation Standards. **Continuing accreditation** is granted for eight years when a program meets all Accreditation Standards.

Continuing accreditation with conditions is granted when a program does not meet one or two Accreditation Standards. The program will submit a Follow-Up Report in two years (18 months for practical nursing programs) addressing the Standard(s) not in compliance. If the Follow-Up Report is accepted by the Commission, the conditions are removed and the program receives accreditation for the remaining years of the eight-year accreditation cycle. **Continuing accreditation with warning** is granted when a program is in non-compliance with more than two Accreditation Standards. The program undergoes a full accreditation visit in two years (18 months for practical nursing programs). **Denial of continuing accreditation** is given when a program with conditions or warning status is reviewed and found to be in continued non-compliance with any Accreditation Standard. The program is removed from the list of accredited programs. It may reinstate the application process for initial accreditation at any time.
