H.B. 372

H.B. 372 was reviewed by the Board which modifies the Utah Construction Trades Licensing Act authorizing a licensed master electrician, residential master electrician, Journeyman electrician, residential journeyman electrician or apprentice electrician to install, repair, or replace an alarm system without being licensed as an alarm company agent.

Mr. Bullock appeared before the Board for his probationary review. Due to the fact that Mr. Bullock had not been able to find employment in the industry, the Board requested that Mr. Bullock voluntarily surrender his license for now then apply when he finds employment. 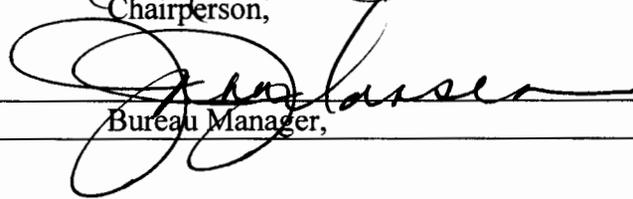
