

**RICH COUNTY COMMISSION  
MINUTES  
ARRIL 1, 2015**

The Rich County Commission Meeting was held on April 1, 2015 at the County Courthouse in Randolph, Utah beginning at 10:00 a.m. Those present were Chairman William E. Cox, Commissioner Norman A. Weston, Commissioner Thomas J. Weston and Clerk Rebecca Peart.

A motion was made by Tom Weston and seconded by Norm Weston and unanimously passed to approve the April 1, 2015 agenda as presented with the addition of a tabled item under Assessor business.

**Scott Crosby, Mike Capron, Dave Oram from Swan Creek and Scott Jacobson Rich County Sanitation** met with the Commission to discuss the sanitation pick up at Swan Creek Subdivision. They brought a map and showed different options. They stated the subdivision does not own the property where the dumpsters are now located. They would like to change the pick-up location. A motion was made by Norm Weston to allow the Sanitation to relocate the dumpsters to the cul-de-sac on Mackinaw Way while Swan Creek Homeowners pursue a permanent location. This will be a temporary location until October 1, 2015. Tom Weston seconded the motion and unanimously passed.

**David Harris Regional Manager with Utah State Parks** met with the Commission and discussed the proposed gun range and the proposed site. He stated that the State Parks are in favor of the range and will be willing to host it on the proposed site. The Commission will coordinate with other agencies and set a public hearing date. Expansion of the Bear Lake Marina was also discussed.

**Jill Parker Public Relations Director with Bear River Health Department** met with the Commission to present the 2014 Annual Report. The report was reviewed and also many of their Services. Different programs they offer were discussed. Randolph and Garden City have buildings that house the Health Department

**Lou Jean Argyle Rich County Recorder** met with the Commission regarding a letter she had received from Norman Mecham requesting the money sent be applied first to the 2010 taxes on properties that are set for tax sale. A motion was made by Norm Weston to allow the Treasurer to apply the money received on the Legands and Shundaha to the 2010 back taxes. Tom Weston seconded the motion and unanimously passed.

**Kim Wilson Rich County Assessor** met with the Commission to discuss personal property exemptions. Assessor Wilson presented **personal property** exemptions that she had received. The Commissioners reviewed each application. Norm Weston made a motion to approve the personal property exemptions as presented. Tom Weston seconded the motion and unanimously approved. Kim had not visited the Thomas Dee property that was tabled last month. Norm Weston made a motion to table this matter another month for Kim to visit the site. Tom Weston seconded the motion and unanimously passed.

**Bob Hunter, A.J. Franks, and Mitch McBride with United Way** met with the Commission to explore putting Rich County on United Way of Northern Utah. They want people to Give. Advocate. and Volunteer. United Way of Northern Utah is committed to meet the basic needs of families and the community. They will visit with the School District and others in the Community and report back to the Commission.

A motion was made by Norm Weston seconded by Tom Weston and unanimously passed to renew our 1 year County Silver Membership with the American Lands Council in the amount of \$2,200.00

A motion was made by Tom Weston seconded by Norm Weston and unanimously passed to enter into an agreement with the Town of Randolph to put in a 2 inch water line to the Courthouse for the purpose of putting in a new sprinkler system. The amount will be \$3,500.00.

A motion was made by Norm Weston to enter into an agreement with Big Door Entertainment for the Charley Jenkins concert on August 13, 2015 in the amount of \$3500.00. Deposit to be paid now is \$1750.00. Tom Weston seconded the motion and unanimously passed.

A motion was made by Norm Weston to accept the bid from Clark Siddoway to remove old trim and install new trim in the Courthouse and make 2 oak cabinets to match the trim. Tom Weston seconded the motion and unanimously passed.

Commissioner Tom Weston made a motion to approve the March 4, 2015 **Minutes** and the motion was seconded by Commissioner Norm Weston and unanimously approved.

A motion was made by Tom Weston, and seconded by Norm Weston and unanimously passed to approve the **CURRENT EXPENDITURES** as presented.

With no further business before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
