Yalecrest Local Historic District Designation – A request by the Yalecrest Yes Heritage Preservation Committee to have the Salt Lake City Historic Landmark Commission consider the designation of a local historic district within the Yalecrest neighborhood which is located generally between 900 South/Sunnyside Avenue and 1300 South, from 1300 East to 1900 East. At the public hearing, the Historic Landmark Commission may decide whether or not to submit an application for a Zoning Map amendment to establish an H Historic Preservation Overlay district for all or part of the Yalecrest neighborhood and forward a recommendation regarding potential boundaries for the local historic district to the Planning Commission and the City Council. The area is located in City Council District 5 represented by Jill Remington Love and District 6 represented by JT Martin. (Staff contact: Carl Leith, (801) 535-7758, carl.leith@slcgov.com.)

There is currently no petition number for the above item as the Historic Landmark Commission must decide whether or not to submit an application.
