The March 4, 2015 meeting of the Secondhand Merchandise Advisory Board (Board) began at 8:00am with Chairman of the Board, Mike Katsanevas, conducting the meeting. The Chairman called the meeting to order.

A quorum of at least nine (9) board members was met at this meeting.

### Agenda Items:

#### **1. APPROVE PREVIOUS BOARD MEETING MINUTES**

Chairman Mike Katsanevas asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2014 board minutes. Board Member Brad Jenkins made the motion, which was seconded by Board Member Mike Malay and passed unanimously.

## **2. TRAINING LOCATION CONFIRMATION**

Investigator Glen Minson asked whether locations for the Ogden and Price pawn training sessions had been finalized. Detective Millard informed the Board that Price's location has been set, Ogden's location is still being arranged, and there is a possibility that the location of the Provo training is double booked and may need to be adjusted.

## **3. LEGISLATIVE UPDATE**

Chairman Katsanevas spoke to the Board about the 2015 legislative session, including the status of S.B. 36. Katsanevas relayed that there has been some discussion that the legislature may open the pawn bill and re-write it completely.

## **4. OPEN FORUM FOR DISCUSSION**

Chairman Katsanevas next raised the issue of liability of hosting an industry message board separate from the database. He asked if there was a possibility of the State of Utah paying for the hosting fees and being reimbursed by Katsanevas. Investigator Minson asked the members of the Board to put together a written request to bring to the Division to consider. Detective Brewer mentioned that it may be better to utilize UTORCA for the sort of notices contemplated instead of creating a new forum.
