MOTION TO APPROVED MINUTES FROM LAST MEETING, KOORING, LICHENBERG

AARON MCKINLEY- MR MCKINLEY'S PERMIT WAS DENIED BASED ON A 2011 IMPAIRED DRIVING CONVICTION, CLASS B. MR MCKINLEY THEN STATES THAT HE RECEIVED THE IMPAIRED DRIVING BECAUSE HE WAS TAKING ABIEN SLEEP AID. MR MCKINLEY THEN INFORMS BOARD THAT HE NO LONGER TAKES THIS DRUG. THE ORIGINAL CHARGE WAS A DUI. SINCE THE TIME OF ARREST HE HAS BEEN THROUGH POST AND IS LEOJ CERTIFIED. WOULD LIKE PERMIT TO CARRY FOR WORK AS WELL AS PERSONAL REASONS. CLAIMS THAT HE DOES NOT REMEMBER THE INCIDENT, IT WAS MORE LIKE A DREAM HE STATES. DOES HOWEVER REMEMBER PARTS OF THE ARREST. IS CURRENTLY WORKING FOR DAVIS COUNTY AS A RESERVE OFFICER AND THEY ARE AWARE OF THE CHARGE. MOTION TO GO OUT OF CLOSED SESSION APOSHIAN, KOORING SECONDS. APOSHIAN WITHDRAWLS PREVIOUS MOTION, KOORING SECONDS. MOTION TO OVERTURN THE STATE LOYD, APOSHIAN SECONDS. UNANIMOUS. OVERTURNED.

LEONARD SMUIN -MR SMUIN PERMIT WAS SUSPENDED BASED ON A 1978 FELONY CONVICTION. MR SMUIN THEN STATES THAT HE AND A BUDDIE WRECKED A JEEP ON STATE STREET, BUT PHIL INFORMS HIM THAT IS NOT THE SAME CASE. MR SMUIN THEN INDICATES THAT HE HAD NO IDEA WHAT THIS CASE IS? HAS GONE TO THE 4<sup>TH</sup> DISTRICT COURT IN VERNAL AND RECEIVED A CERTIFIED COPY INDICATING THIS CHARGE DOES NOT EXIST WITHIN THERE COURT. ROBERTS MOTIONS TO REINSATED PERMIT, APOSHIAN SECONDS. MOTION TO TAKE A 10 MINUTE BREAK ROBERTS, LICHENBERG SECONDS. BOARD GIVES AG'S OFFICE AS WELL AS BCI 45 DAYS TO GET THIS FIGURED OUT THEN BOARD WILL GIVE MR SMUIN HIS PERMIT BACK ROBERTS, LOYD SECONDS. APOSHIAN NAY. UNANIMOUS

SAMANTHA MCCULLOUGH- MS MCCULLOUGH PERMIT WAS DENIED BASED ON A 2008 DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CONVICTION. MS MCCULLOUGH THEN STATES THAT HER LAST NAME AT THE TIME OF ARREST WAS HILL NOT HALL. CLAIMS THAT

SHE WAS IN A RELATIONSHIP WITH HER PARTNER AT THE TIME AND THE GOT INTO A FIGHT IN THE CAR. ASKED TO BE LET OUT AND SHE WOULD WALK THE REST OF THE WAY HOME. THE GIRLFRIEND DID PULL OVER AND LET HER OUT, BUT CAME BACK WHICH RESULTED IN A PHYSICAL ALTERCATION. MS MCCULLOUGH KNEW WHAT SHE DID WAS WRONG. PLED GUILTY TO THIS CHARGE, BUT ALSO THOUGHT SHE HAD ENTERED IN A PLEA IN ABEYANCE. WAS UNDER THE IMPRESSION THAT IT WOULD BE DISMISSED ONCE SHE COMPLETED HER PROBATION.
