## **EAC Quarterly Division Award – 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2015**

### **Victims Services**

I would like to nominate West Valley City Victims Services for the Division of the Quarter. Victims Services willingness to always go over and above expectations, and their excellent service to the citizens of West Valley, should be recognized. These three recent examples, all from the same night, illustrate that excellence.

First Merari Lopez assisted a victim who was intimidated by obtaining a protective order and wouldn't have been able to follow through the process without assistance, because she did not have transportation. Merari provided transportation to the court and stayed with her for four hours to get the protective order. During this time Merari also discovered the victim hadn't filled her prescriptions because she didn't have a vehicle, so she drove her to two different pharmacies to make sure she got them filled. Merari then reported to work two hours early the following day to return to the court house so a judge could sign and finalize the paperwork for the protective order.

Second, Alexandra Perez was called out to a scene where a domestic violence victim had been struck in the head multiple times. The victim asked Alexandra if she would go to the hospital with her because she didn't have any family or friends in Utah. Alexandra stayed with the victim while she received medical treatment and afterwards called three different shelters in order to find space for the victim since it wasn't safe for her to return home. Alexandra also purchased food for the victim, paid for with her own money, before taking the victim to the shelter. By the time she returned to the office it was after 9:00 pm.

Third, Sharla Smith had a victim who arrived at the office with her 10-month old baby, after walking in the rain. Sharla gave the victim her own gym clothes and some blankets. She then called four different shelters all of which were full, so the victim called her father in New Mexico and asked him to pick her up. Her father agreed to pick her up the following day. Sharla arranged for the victim and her baby to spend the night in a motel, and then gave the victim some money, taken from her own pocket, to buy dinner. Sharla remained in the office after working hours to make sure the victim and her baby were taken care of.

West Valley City Victim Services, and the citizens of West Valley City are fortunate to have such dedicated and caring victim advocates. All of the hard working advocates have similar stories and the entire division should be honored.

**ISSUE:**

Purchase a new Tymco 600 Sweeper valued at \$238,150.00 less \$85,000.00 trade-in value of a Tymco 600 Sweeper.

**SYNOPSIS:**

Intermountain Sweeper submitted a proposal to the Public Works Department. The proposal qualifies under the provisions of the West Valley City Procurement Code 5-3-110, Procurement to Meet Existing Needs. The code allows the procurement of matching equipment when it is beneficial to operations and maintenance. The Fleet Manager and Operations Managers have negotiated the best price available.

**BACKGROUND:**

Street sweepers are high maintenance vehicles. The current policy of replacing sweepers every four years has proven economical by avoiding high repair costs and recouping high trade-in values for the old sweepers. The street sweeper being replaced is a 2011 Tymco 600.

The Public Works Department has used Tymco sweepers for many years, and has been pleased with the equipment performance, and the customer service received from Intermountain Sweeper, the local Tymco vendor.

To ensure the City is receiving the best value, bids were solicited from all vendors last year. The 2014 bid submitted by Intermountain Sweeper for a Tymco 600 sweeper best met the City's requirements, and was also the lowest cost bid submitted.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Approve the purchase of the Tymco 600 Sweeper, with a 2011 Tymco 600 Sweeper as a trade-in. Cost of the new sweeper is \$238,150 minus the trade-in value of \$85,000, with the net purchase cost at \$153,150.

**ISSUE:**

A resolution accepting an insurance proposal with Workers Compensation Fund (“WCF”) for renewal of a full indemnity plan for West Valley City’s workers compensation claims.

**SYNOPSIS:**

WCF provides a full indemnity plan for claims for a monthly premium. Full indemnity means that WCF not only processes and pays claims, but administers all workers compensation related matters, including litigation.

**BACKGROUND:**

WCF currently provides full indemnity workers compensation insurance which means that WCF would handle all aspects of workers compensation claims for a monthly premium. The transition to the WCF was highly successful and resulted in increased efficiency and decreased costs during our first year with WCF. This year, the City’s premium will be reduced by approximately \$102,000 as a result of coordination with WCF and effective risk management and prevention by the City.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

City staff recommends approval of the resolution by the City Council.



INSURANCE COVERAGE

Coverage for acts of terrorism is included in your policy. You are hereby notified that under the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act, as amended in 2007, the definition of act of terrorism has changed. As defined in Section 102(1) of the Act: The term "act of terrorism" means any act that is certified by the Secretary of the Treasury--in concurrence with the Secretary of State, and the Attorney General of the United States--to be an act of terrorism; to be a violent act or an act that is dangerous to human life, property, or infrastructure; to have resulted in damage within the United States, or outside the United States in the case of certain air carriers or vessels or the premises of a United States mission; and to have been committed by an individual or individuals as part of an effort to coerce the civilian population of the United States or to influence the policy or affect the conduct of the United States Government by coercion. Under your coverage, any losses resulting from certified acts of terrorism may be partially reimbursed by the United States Government under a formula established by the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act, as amended. However, your policy may contain other exclusions which might affect your coverage, such as an exclusion for nuclear events. Under the formula, the United States Government generally reimburses 85% of covered terrorism losses exceeding the statutorily established deductible paid by the insurance company providing the coverage. The Terrorism Risk Insurance Act, as amended, contains a \$100 billion cap that limits U.S. Government reimbursement as well as insurers' liability for losses resulting from certified acts of terrorism when the amount of such losses exceeds \$100 billion in any one calendar year. If the aggregate insured losses for all insurers exceed \$100 billion, your coverage may be reduced.
