A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SOUTH SALT LAKE CITY COUNCIL
GRANTING PERMISSION FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO
APPROPRIATE CERTAIN PROPERTY IN ITS POSSESSION TO PUBLIC
INTEREST USE.

WHEREAS, the South Salt Lake City Police Department has acquired possession of currency, bicycles and other property (lists of which are attached to this resolution) as evidence, found property, or for safekeeping, is authorized pursuant to state law to dispose of the property, has made reasonable efforts to identify and notify owners of the property, and has either been unsuccessful in determining ownership over the property, or has notified the apparent owner and has not received a timely response;

WHEREAS, Utah Code permits the City Council to authorize the appropriation of these monies and property to public use by transferring money to the general fund of the City, auctioning or selling items, or donating the property to a nonprofit charity registered with the state; and

WHEREAS, the City has published notice of the potential appropriation of this property, and will provide adequate time for the public to respond to this notice,

BE IT RESOLVED, therefore, by the City Council of the City of South Salt Lake that, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 24-3-103 & 77-24a-5, the property identified on the lists accompanying this resolution may be appropriated for public interest use by: (1) donating the listed bicycles to the Bicycle Collective, a non-profit organization which is registered with the state and which serves our community, and (2) transferring the identified monies to the general fund for expenditure on city services and obligations.
