The Vineyard Town Council held a Special Session on August 24, 2015 starting at 7:11 PM in the Vineyard Town Hall. The invocation was offered by Councilmember Fernandez.

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**Regular Session -** The meeting was called to order at 7:11 PM.

**BUSINESS ITEMS:**

**1.1 DISCUSSION AND ACTION – Municipal Primary Election Canvass**

The Mayor and Town Council will sit as the Board of Canvassers to certify results of the 2015 Primary General Election.

The Town Clerk/Recorder Pamela Spencer explained the results of the returns and mentioned that the vote by mail was a success with 40 percent of ballots returned. She reported the statistics of voters by area/subdivision from the election night: The Shores 23%; The Lakes at Sleepy Ridge 25%; Holdaway Road 35%; The Garden 2%; and LeCheminant 15%. She explained that the statistics might change a little after she adds in the vote-by-mail ballots received after the Primary Election Day and the provisional ballots.

Boardmember Goodman called for a motion.

**Motion:** BOARDMEMBER RILEY MOVED TO CERTIFY THE RESULTS OF THE AUGUST 11, 2015 MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION, FOR THE NOMINATION OF FOUR (4) CANDIDATES WHO WOULD RUN FOR THE OFFICE OF COUNCILMEMBER IN THE GENERAL ELECTION. BOARDMEMBER FERNANDEZ SECONDED THE MOTION.
