Mayor Christensen welcomed everyone to the meeting. Pledge of Allegiance was offered by John Christensen and the Prayer was given by Catherine.

Marvin Fox was present at the meeting to talk to the council about his driveway into his home. He said that when they redid the road they left a dip in his driveway so now when they pull out his car it hits the bottom. Garrick stated that he had met with Mr. Fox and he felt like we need to put in a new culvert to fix the problem and it would cost the town about \$800.00. After some discussion the council told Garrick to go ahead and put in the culvert.

Bill K. Christensen from the Mafield Irrigation Co. was present talk to the council about a project that they are trying to move forward with. He stated that the Mayfield Irrigation Co. has a non use permit for their 400 acre feet of water that they have for storage right. The permit will be up within a couple of years and they have contacted the Forest Service about a piece of property above the pond that would like to get for a storage pond. The Forest Service has turned them down but the Irrigation Company has contacted the County Commissioners and they have given their support and is going to write a letter to the Division of Natural Resources and they would like to have the town write a letter also stating their support of the project. After some discussion Billie made the motion to support the Irrigation Company and to write a letter in support, seconded by Eric. Motion carried.

Billie stated that she had a cattle guard that the town can have to use up at the cemetery.
