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Discovery turn-around times are 14 calendar days if served on or before December 4, 2015, and 7 calendar days if served thereafter. Where feasible, parties shall serve discovery requests and responses on applicable parties by electronic mail.

Community Water has provided notice to its customers that a rate case has been filed. Community Water shall promptly notify its customers of the schedule in this matter and file the notice with the Commission for the record.

NOTICES OF HEARING

The following provisions apply to both hearings noticed under this heading.

The Commission may limit presentation of testimony or comments that are unduly repetitious. Individuals wishing to provide public witness testimony or comment must appear at this hearing at the appointed time.
