COUNCIL MEETING

SEPTEMBER 1, 2015

The Nephi City Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 21 East 100 North at 7:30 p.m. Tuesday, September 1, 2015.

Mayor Jones called the meeting to order and welcomed all present and Council Member Park offered the invocation.

The minutes of the council meeting held on August 18, 2015 were presented for approval. Council Member Park made the motion that the minutes for the August 18, 2015 city council meeting be approved as written; Council Member Seely seconded the motion, which passed on a unanimous vote.

Mayor Jones introduced Robert Stroud as the new recreation program coordinator. Mr. Stroud updated the council on recent Nephi Recreation activities, including the summer fitness program, the biathlon and the youth triathlon. He presented a copy of the September recreation newsletter to each council member.

Mel Leseberg, from Jviation, Inc. updated the council on the progress of the apron expansion project currently under construction at the airport. Jviation is the consulting engineering firm that has designed the project and is carrying out the construction management and inspection. Mr. Leseberg said that the project has included several local subcontractors, that it is ahead of schedule and the estimated completion date is September 29, 2015.

Glenn Greenhalgh, planning commission chairman, updated the council on the recent and upcoming activities of the planning commission. O'Reilly Auto Parts have presented a site plan to the commission for a new business by Shopko. Mt. Nebo Market has presented a site plan for an expansion of their building. The Commission is discussing a new sign ordinance and will be presenting their recommendations to the council in the future.

Mayor Jones appointed Lisa E. Brough to be the City Recorder and asked the council to approve that appointment. Council Member Seely made the motion for approval, and Council Member Gee seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of the appointment.

Council Member Rowley made the motion to ratify the hiring of Cody Robinson and Jaynette Grimard as seasonal parks and cemeteries workers. Council Member Park seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of the hiring.

Council Member Rowley reviewed a business license application and then made the motion to approve a business license for Adventure Sports Technology, LLC at 55 West 200 North. Council Member Park seconded the motion. Voting on the motion to approve the business license was unanimous in favor.

A list of claims against the city was presented on the warrant register. Council Member Seely made the motion to pay claims #16-191 thru #16-409 with funds appropriated. Council Member Gee seconded the motion. Voting on the motion was unanimous in favor of paying the claims.

Council Member Gee made the motion to adjourn the meeting, and Council Member Rowley seconded the motion which passed on a unanimous vote.

The council meeting adjourned at 8:45 p.m.
