Re: Policies Expedited in September 2015

Per Policy 101 *Policies Governing Policies*, non-substantive changes to policies are made through the expedited policy process. These changes require approval by President’s Council and notification to the Board of Trustees. Two policies underwent non-substantive change through the expedited policy process in September.

Policy 205 *Investments*

The title of “Vice President of Administration and Legislative Affairs” was updated to “Vice President of Finance and Administration.”

Policy 425 *Scheduling Campus Facilities*

In section 4.5, the original wording gave the impression that any activity by a non-university entity must be sponsored by a university department. Current language: “The hosted event must be supported in full or part by a university department, UVUSA, or university-chartered club and scheduled as part of the university entity’s mission . . .” Non-university entities may rent space as provided by Policy 425 and are not required to be sponsored by a university entity. To provide clarity, that language was changed to “~~The hosted~~ [Each co-sponsored](#) event must be supported in full or part by a university department, UVUSA, or university-chartered club and scheduled as part of the university entity’s mission.”
