SUMMARY: Over the last several weeks staff has been working with an urban designer on potential designs for the park space at Taylorsville City Center. The attached drawing illustrates the latest iteration of the design. The plan features new plaza space; restrooms; a multi-use stage; an internal circulation system that could accommodate community events such as farmers markets, etc.; an informal amphitheater for movies in the park, musical performances, etc.; and an impressive gateway entrance from 5400 South.


Staff will present a slightly updated drawing as well as show some of the other design options for discussion at the City Council meeting.



RADIAL CONCEPT UPDATED

This concept strengthens the circular and radial patterns established on the site. Characteristics are as follows:

- Welcoming arc with ornamental trees
- Berms to create some topography and seclusion from 5400 South.
- Large shade trees
- Multi-purpose twin plaza area.
- Water fountains, wading pools, and other water features.
- Play field





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
