STAFF RECOMMENDATION:


Staff recommends approval of a Resolution designating the Election Day Vote Centers and appointing Poll Workers for the 2015 Municipal Elections.

BACKGROUND DISCUSSION:

In accordance with Section 20A-3-302 of the Utah Code, the City Council is authorized to conduct the entire election by absentee ballot. The City conducted the 2013 Municipal Election entirely by absentee ballot and increased the voter turnout from 16% in 2011 to 34%.

When an Election is conducted entirely by absentee ballot, the City shall provide at least one Election Day voting center in accordance with Section 20A-3-7 of the Utah Code. The City will have two Vote Centers with three Poll Workers at each location. The Vote Centers and Poll Workers are listed below:

**A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE ELECTION DAY VOTE
CENTERS AND APPOINTING POLL WORKERS FOR THE 2015
MUNICIPAL ELECTION, AND SET THE COMPENSATION FOR
THEIR SERVICES**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 20A-3-302 of the Utah Code, the City Council is authorized to conduct the entire election by absentee ballot, and

WHEREAS, the City conducted the 2013 Municipal Election entirely by absentee ballot and increased the voter turnout from 16% in 2011 to 34%, and

WHEREAS, when an Election is conducted entirely by absentee ballot, the City shall provide at least one Election Day voting center in accordance with Section 20A-3-7 of the Utah Code, and

WHEREAS, the City will have two Vote Centers with three Poll Workers at each location, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of West Jordan, Utah desires to designate the Election Day Vote Centers, and make the Poll Worker appointments, set their compensation, and provide for other matters relating to them.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF WEST JORDAN, UTAH:

Section 1. Designating Election Day Vote Centers. The City will provide the following two Election Date Vote Centers open during the hours of 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.:

BINGHAM CREEK LIBRARY
4834 West 9000 South

Section 2. Appointing Poll Workers and setting their Compensation. The following individuals are hereby appointed to serve as poll works with the compensation as stated. The compensation for each Poll Worker will be as set for each Election Day they actually serve: Poll Coordinator, \$295.00, and both Poll Technicians, \$250.00.
