NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Carbon County Board of County Commissioners will hold a Public Hearing on Wednesday, November 18, 2015 as close to 4:30 p.m. as possible in the Commission Chambers of the Carbon County Administration Building located at 751 East 100 North, Price, Utah 84501. The purpose of the Public Hearing is to consider all written protests filed and to hear all comments and objections relating to proposed improvements to a roadway which includes pavement of the Hilltop Road from the end of the current pavement around West Gordon Creek Road to the end of Hilltop Road and also the creation of a Special Tax Assessment Area to be known as Carbon County, Utah Special Tax Assessment Area No. 2015-1 (Hill Subdivision).
