ISSUE SUMMARY:

The Unified Fire Authority District is currently in the process of planning and constructing a new fire station located at 4965 South Redwood Road. The new firestation is going to be built where the old Plymouth Elementary School was located. The old Plymouth Elementary School is an important part of the City's heritage, and residents of the City would like to see that heritage preserved as the City moves toward a more modern and innovative future. The City understands that the Unified Fire Authority District has sole discretion to name the new fire station as the District so chooses. However, the City would like to take this opportunity to recommend a potential name for the new fire station that would preserve the heritage of Plymouth Elementary School by including the term "Plymouth" in the name. The name the City would like to recommend to the District is "Taylorsville Plymouth Fire Station 117."

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE RECOMMENDING TO THE
UNIFIED FIRE AUTHORITY DISTRICT THAT THE NEW FIRE STATION
LOCATED AT 4965 SOUTH REDWOOD ROAD BE NAMED "TAYLORSVILLE
PLYMOUTH FIRE STATION 117"**

WHEREAS, the Taylorsville City Council (the "Council") met in regular session on November 4, 2015, to consider, among other things, recommending to the Unified Fire Authority District that the new fire station located at 4965 South Redwood Road be named "Taylorsville Plymouth Fire Station 117"; and

WHEREAS, the Unified Fire Authority District is currently in the process of planning and constructing a new fire station located at 4965 South Redwood Road in the City of Taylorsville (the "City"); and

WHEREAS, the new fire station will be built where the old Plymouth Elementary School was located; and

WHEREAS, the old Plymouth Elementary School is an important part of the City's heritage which residents and the City strive to preserve; and

WHEREAS, the City understands that the Unified Fire Authority District (the "District") has sole discretion to name the new fire station as the District chooses; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it would be in the best interests of the citizens of the City if the name of the new fire station preserved the heritage of Plymouth Elementary School by including "Plymouth" in the new station's name.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Taylorsville City Council hereby recommends to the Unified Fire Authority District that the new fire station located at 4965 South Redwood Road be named "Taylorsville Plymouth Fire Station 117."

This Resolution, assigned Resolution No. 15-30, shall take effect immediately upon passage and acceptance as provided herein.
