**DEDICATION:** Superintendent Brotherson conducted the meeting which opened with the cub scouts presenting the Flag and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Kevin Madsen presented the building as completed and complimented the builders, Westland Construction. President Thacker accepted the building and noted the quality of design and workmanship. Bruce Guymon remarked on the functioning of the building and the positive impact on learning for students. Mr. Richens offered a dedicatory prayer. A group of 4<sup>th</sup> graders sang a freshly composed school song.

President Thacker concluded the dedication and opened a public meeting inviting interested parties to present arguments in favor of and against the ballot proposition with respect to the issuance of general obligation bonds.

The argument for the issuance of bonds prepared by the District was reviewed. It was noted the bonds and resulting new Union High School would accommodate the growing student population, that the building master plan would stay on track, and that interest rates are low and building costs have declined recently. The tax base had declined some this past year, but is still five times what it used to be.

There being no one else desiring to present any further arguments, President Thacker closed the meeting.
