Mayor Pro Tem Keith Thompson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He welcomed the council and all others present. Randy Branch led us in the pledge of allegiance and Keith Thompson offered the opening prayer.

Mayor Pro Tem Keith Thompson called for a motion to accept the agenda.

Randy Branch made a motion to accept the agenda as it is written. Jennifer Webb 2nd. All council members present voted yes.

The minutes were approved from last town council meeting.

Mayor Heyder took a minute to explain that he is here to listen and give his opinion and stay up on what is going on but he will not be voting on and decisions because of his health issues

Sargent Somerall and Deputy Jordan

Deputy Jordan presented some statistics showing that things are going good and more deputies have been in the area patrolling. Mayor Heyder stated that Keith and him are trying to set up a meeting with the highway patrol, the sheriff and the sheriff from Oneida county. We have some serious problems out here and Mayor Heyder would like to get them solved.

Jim Somerall stated that the whole Sheriff's department is being restructured. They are making shift changes that will put more manpower out on the street. The sergeants will be out on the street to supervise. Snowville should see an increased amount of patrolling. These changes will take place November 1st.

Jim Somerall shared some information about the last 5 years. There has been a steady incline in the amount of calls in Snowville. Sergeant Somerall stated that he realized that there have been some problems with dispatch and he indicated that this will stop. He is personally taking care of the problem.

Sergeant Somerall stated they will also be doing saturation patrols where 4 or 5 Sheriffs will come out and enforce. The purpose is to come and show their presence. Mayor Heyder thanked him and said that these are great changes that need to help.

CDBG Grant-Eric & Tammie

Eric stated that we will be having a preconstruction for the South Stone Rd Project meeting on Thursday at 3:00 p.m.

The fire station project is complete. Eric turned in a work order agreement to do the water study on the well. He asked Keith Thompson to sign it.

Mayor Heyder asked Eric to bring him up to date on the Stone Road Project. Eric showed the mayor the project plans.

Planning and Zoning

Keith Thompson brought up a nuisance ordinance that he would like to pass. Mayor Heyder stated that we need to send that into the lawyer and ask his opinion on it. Keith will take that into the lawyer to have him review it.

Keith Thompson had some books made up of the planning and zoning. Each council member has an assigned number book that needs to be turned in when they leave office.

The lawyer is still making changes on the documents and when that happens we will have to update the books. Mayor Heyder said that he is very impressed with our lawyer Malone Molgard. He has been out and driven around our town to become familiar.

Water Dept.

There are a couple of resolutions that need to be made on our water ordinance that states that when a person becomes delinquent they need to pay \$100 fee instead of \$50 and pay six months in advance before their water will be turned back on. Also Alan would like to make a resolution to when we sale water to construction companies their will be a fine for those who do not use the correct hydrant or who get caught filling up at the wrong hydrant. Tim suggested that we get with the Lawyer to help write these resolutions. We will plan on passing them next council meeting.

Alan said that we need to get a couple of leaks fixed and he is waiting for the guys that usually do it to get out to fix them.

Tim asked Tammie to call other towns and get prices for water sold to construction companies to get an idea. Tim also stated that we need to be careful that our system doesn't get contaminated.

Fire Dept.

Willie or Andrew is not here to report. Tammie indicated that she received a letter and gave it to Willie Heyder about the recent ISO audit. It stated they could call and make arrangements to help keep our ISO score from going down. The letter stated they needed to have training records. Tammie will talk to Willie again and remind him.

Ambulance Report

September there were 2 charges entered, totaling \$4556.99 The revenues collected for the month were \$1955.45. Mike has registered all of the emt's for training conference in December. We receive a grant to get reimbursed for these expenses.

Park & Cemetery

The Cemetery is winterized and the Park has been winterized this week.

Old and Other New Business

Jennifer Webb and her committee are planning a Halloween activity on Saturday at the town hall from 6:00-7:30 p.m. there will be a trunk or treat and spook alley with homemade root beer and rice crispy treats.

Randy said he needs new garbage cans. Tammie will call and find out the price for next council meeting. Randy also brought up some people who are in the county are getting the city rates and others are complaining. Tammie will check with Dave Church the attorney for the Utah League of Cities and Towns.

Tammie asked if she could get a motion to purchase a new laptop for the town so she doesn't have to use her own and the town needs a new computer anyway.

Randy Branch made a motion for Tammie to purchase a new computer for up to \$1500.00. Jennifer Webb 2nd. All council members present voted yes.
