- Removing 8.5” of existing pavement and replacing with new asphalt




I-215; 4700 South to S.R. 201

- Adding new auxiliary lanes
- Completing minor interchange modifications
- Reconstructing bridge over S.R. 201




I-215; 4700 South to S.R. 201
Intersection at I-215 and S.R. 201





What to Expect

Westbound I-215 from Redwood Road to 300 East

- Night and weekend work
- Lane closures and width restrictions
- Approximately two to three months

I-215 from 4700 S to S.R. 201

- Long-term lane closures and width restrictions
- Intermittent ramp closures
- Short-term closure of S.R. 201 interchange while the newly built bridge is moved
- Approximately 20 months
