Community Development Block Grant & Emergency Solutions Programs

Residents Invited to Help the City Prioritize Grant Funding Requests

The Salt Lake City Housing and Neighborhood Development Division invites residents to participate in a public open house to learn more about 2016-17 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding requests.

Each year Salt Lake City receives CDBG and ESG grant funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The primary objective of CDBG funds is to develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment, principally for low and moderate income persons. ESG funds are to be used to assist individuals and families regain housing stability after experiencing a housing or homelessness crisis.

The City is in the process of an extensive grant application review process that will determine the best way to allocate CDBG and ESG funds. The open house will provide an opportunity for the public to review applications for funding, speak with the applicants, vote on funding priorities and provide comment.
