DISCUSSION: Policy Discussion - R277-439 *Split Enrollment for Public School Students*
(New)

Background:

Students and parents, including parents of home school students, have expressed interest in enrolling in more than one public school at a time. The purpose of this new rule is to establish standards and procedures for a regularly enrolled public school student or a home school student who is participating in dual enrollment, to attend more than one public school at the same time.

Key Points:

Many students currently enroll in two or more public schools, at the discretion of the public schools. The committee will discuss policy options to establish a procedure for a public school student or a home school student participating in dual enrollment, to enroll in two or more public schools at the same time.

Anticipated Action:

The Law and Licensing Committee will discuss the policy options related to student enrollment in two or more public schools and direct staff to create R277-439 to bring back to the Committee in January for consideration.
