- 4. CITY ATTORNEY COMMENTS. City Attorney, Lyn Creswell, mentioned that there will be some training provided by staff in December for the four new City Council members who will be joining us in January.
- 5. CITY COUNCIL COMMENTS. Council Member Rapp expressed his gratitude to the veterans who have sacrificed for our country.

Council Member Beverly expressed her appreciation of the South Salt Lake Police and Fire. She would like to see the step increases restored to what they should be. The urgency is with Police. She assured citizens, police and fire fighters that she is committed to restoring those steps. She appreciates their service.

6. INFORMATION. Youth City Council donation. Youth City Council Advisor, Jennifer Allred advised that the Youth City Council sponsored a 5k run on July 4<sup>th</sup> with the proceeds to be donated to the Nepal earthquake victims. They were going to partner with the Bhutanese Community of Utah and send their funds together but when they brought their donation they found the BCU had already made their donation. After searching online it was determined that the only way to make the Youth City Council's donation safely was to pay online using a City credit card. So they will give the money to the City and in turn the City will make the donation by credit card. They wanted the Council to be aware of this transaction. The donation will be for \$583.13.

1. **Downtown South Salt Lake Master Plan.** Community Development and Economic Development Director, Mike Florence, and Urban Design Director, Sharen Hauri reviewed a presentation on the Downtown Master Plan with the Council. A copy is attached to these minutes and incorporated by this reference.

Council Member Rapp asked about snow removal when there isn't any place to put it.

Ms. Hauri advised that they have fifteen foot sidewalks that have a built in buffer and street parking on every street. They only have excess snow once or twice a year and at those times the snow will be pushed to the street parking area like it is in the residential areas.

Mr. Florence advised the Council that staff will bring this back to the Council in ordinance form at their next meeting, December 2, 2015.

Mayor Wood announced that they can now go public with the grocery store that is coming to South Salt Lake. That store is WinCo. They plan to open Thanksgiving of 2016 in the South Salt Lake downtown area.
