2016 Recertification

RECERTIFICATION PROCESS

- City Attorney submits an opinion letter outlining the requirements of a Justice Court.
- The Judge submits an affidavit that the court meets statutory parameters
- The City Council passes a resolution requesting reauthorization

OVERVIEW OF COURT REQUIREMENTS

- Court business is held at a location conducive to a court
- Court is open hours and days prescribed by the State
- Compensation for the Judge meets parameters outlined by the State
- Court employee training is provided
- Public prosecutors and public defenders (as needed) are provided
- Fine monies are handled as required using State software
- Courtroom is furnished as prescribed
- Security is provided as prescribed
- Staffing meets standards (min. 1 Judge 3 clerks)

RESOLUTION CONTENT

- Request the Justice Courts Standards Committee to recertify the court
- Affirms the City's willingness to continue to meet court standards
- Authorize staff to complete any other necessary steps in the recertification process.
