

Several areas of BLM land in Millard County have been proposed by outside environmental groups to become wilderness. The Board of Millard County Commissioners has consistently opposed these wilderness proposals. Millard County desires to clarify and re-affirm its position and policy in favor of multiple use/sustained yield management for each of these proposed wilderness areas and against designating these areas wilderness, or managing them as wilderness, or otherwise treating them as wilderness.

Therefore, it is proposed that Millard County's general plan be amended to reaffirm Millard County's pro multiple use/sustained yield, anti-wilderness policies for each of these proposed wilderness units.
