Mayor Donald Brown brought the Council Meeting to order with The Pledge of Allegiance.

***Minutes Approval** Chris Palmer moved to accept November 19, 2015 minutes. Motion seconded by Brent Larson, all voting Aye.

***Sewer Lift Station Improvement**

Maintenance/ Aaron Jurado discussed what was happening with the sewer lift stations. All of the parts are here except for a length of pipe coming next week. All of the new lids are ready to be installed. Paramount Cubing has been helping with their loader to lift the lids and will be there to set the new ones in. Both plumbing and electrical contractors have been told that the improvements are to be done before the first of 2016. The work schedule order will be the lift station at Center, 500 S, 150 W 300 N and then the last one will be on the east corner of highway 6&50.

***Clean-Up 112 N Main**

Councilman Palmer said the clean-up done by Makayla and her husband on the Rodriguez property at 112 N Main is progressing and a lot of work has been done. The dumpster they are using has been filled and emptied quite a few times.

***Open and Amend the 2016 General Fiscal Year Budget**

Chris Palmer moved to accept Resolution 15-15-03 to Open and Amend the General Fiscal Year 2016 Budget. Motion seconded by Brent Larson, all voting Aye.
The monies in the general fund will be used to pay off the bleacher loan.

***Discussion/ Mayor and Councilmen**

Brent Larson told the Council his thoughts concerning the Zoning regulations in the Hinckley Town Code Book. He feels the regulations restrict people's freedom, so the regulations are counterproductive. He felt the Town did not need to have commercial and industrial areas. If the Town is not policing the regulations then they should be removed from the Code Book.

Mayor Brown said that the County will be seal chipping Main Street in 2016. The Town has the responsibility of paying for the east and west side of the seal chipping being done from the corner of 200 N Main to the corner of Center Street. It was agreed upon that the LDS Church should put up handicapped parking signs along the sidewalk, in the grass.

This will be the Church's responsibility. Chris Palmer felt there should be more handicapped parking at the park.

The Mayor reminded those present that the Santa park lighting would be Saturday the 5th at 6pm.

Emery Polelonema from Six County Association of Governments will meet with Donald on the 26th of January at 9 am if anyone else is interested in meeting with them; they should come.

***PO Passage** Chris Palmer moved to approve the following PO:

#880371 to Delco Western, for water well treatment repair parts, in the amount of \$1,515.63. Motion seconded by Brent Larson, all voting Aye.

***Bill Payments** Brent Larson moved to approve payment for the bills presented before the Council. Motion seconded by Chris Palmer, all voting Aye.
