RESOLUTION NO. 2015-042

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF PLEASANT GROVE CITY AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN EASEMENT GRANTING ROCKY MOUNTAIN POWER A RIGHT OF WAY THAT IS 15' WIDE AND 620' LONG FOR OVERHEAD POWER LINES AND APPURTENANT ACCESSORY EQUIPMENT FOR THE BLUE ENERGY PROJECT LOCATED AT THE MOUTH OF BATTLE CREEK CANYON AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Pleasant Grove City owns property located at the mouth of Battle Creek Canyon; and

WHEREAS, Rocky Mountain Power would like an easement for a right of way 15 feet in width and 620 feet in length, more or less, for the construction, reconstruction, operation, maintenance, repair, replacement, enlargement, and removal of electric power transmission, distribution and communication lines and all necessary or desirable accessories and appurtenances thereto, including without limitation: supporting towers, poles, props, guys and anchors, including guys and anchors outside of the right of way; wires, fibers, cables and other conductors and conduits therefore; and pads, transformers, switches, vaults and cabinets, on, over, or under the surface of the real property; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to grant said easement to Rocky Mountain Power.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Pleasant Grove, Utah as follows:

SECTION 1.

The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the “Right-of-Way Easement” between Pleasant Grove City and Rocky Mountain Power for property located at the mouth of Battle Creek Canyon, which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”.

RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT

For value received, Pleasant Grove City, ("Grantor"), hereby grants Rocky Mountain Power, an unincorporated division of PacifiCorp its successors and assigns, ("Grantee"), an easement for a right of way 15 feet in width and 620 feet in length, more or less, for the construction, reconstruction, operation, maintenance, repair, replacement, enlargement, and removal of electric power transmission, distribution and communication lines and all necessary or desirable accessories and appurtenances thereto, including without limitation: supporting towers, poles, props, guys and anchors, including guys and anchors outside of the right of way; wires, fibers, cables and other conductors and conduits therefore; and pads, transformers, switches, vaults and cabinets, on, over, or under the surface of the real property of Grantor in **Utah** County, State of **Utah** more particularly described as follows and as more particularly described and/or shown on Exhibit "**A**" attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof:

Legal Description:

Two perpetual easements for overhead power lines and apparent parts thereof, situate in the N1/2 NE1/4 of Section 27, T.5S., R2E., S.L.B.&M., being a strip of land 15.00 feet wide, 7.50 feet each side of the following describe center lines:

Beginning at a point 862.90 feet N.89°37'02"E. along the section line and 683.88 feet SOUTH from the north quarter corner of said Section 27; and running thence N.89°09'17"E. 155.90 feet; thence N.44°41'37"E. 189.00 feet more or less to the easterly boundary line of said Grantor's property.

The sideline boundaries of said strip are to be shortened or extended so as to end on the easterly boundary line of said property. The above described strip of land contains 5173 square feet in area or 0.119 acre.

Beginning at a point in the southerly boundary line of said Grantor's property, which point is 1235.59 feet N.89°37'02"E. along the section line and 464.94 feet SOUTH more or less from the north quarter corner of said Section 27; and running thence N.44°41'37"E. 155.46 feet; thence N.17°54'45"E. 118.68 feet more or less to a northwesterly boundary line of said Grantor's property.

The sideline boundaries of said strip are to be shortened or extended so as to begin on the southerly boundary line and end on the northwesterly boundary line of said property. The above described strip of land contains 3961 square feet in area or 0.091 acre.

Basis of Bearing: N.89°37'02"E. along the section line from the north quarter corner to the northeast corner of Section 27, T.5S., R2E., S.L.B.&M.

Together with the right of access to the right of way from adjacent lands of Grantor for all activities in connection with the purposes for which this easement has been granted; and together with the present and (without payment therefore) the future right to keep the right of way and adjacent lands clear of all brush, trees, timber, structures, buildings and other hazards which might endanger Grantee's facilities or impede Grantee's activities.

At no time shall Grantor place, use or permit any equipment or material of any kind that exceeds twelve (12) feet in height, light any fires, place or store any flammable materials (other than agricultural crops), on or within the boundaries of the right of way. Subject to the foregoing limitations, the surface of the right of way may be used for agricultural crops and other purposes not inconsistent, as determined by Grantee, with the purposes for which this easement has been granted.

The rights and obligations of the parties hereto shall be binding upon and shall benefit their respective heirs, successors and assigns.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, each of the parties hereto waives any right it may have to a trial by jury in respect of litigation directly or indirectly arising out of, under or in connection with this agreement. Each party further waives any right to consolidate any action in which a jury trial has been waived with any other action in which a jury trial cannot be or has not been waived.


