BOARD BUSINESS.....

MOTION TO APPROVE MINUTES FROM LAST MEETING CHRIS, MIKE SCONDS. UNANIMOUS. MOTION TO UPHOLD CURRENT CHAIR NICK ROBERTS A FOR 2016 MIKE, CHRIS SECONDS. ERIC MOTIONS FOR CLARK AS CHAIR. MARCUS SWERS IN ALL APPEALING APPLICANTS AS WELL AS THE STATE.

AGENDA.....

WAYNE CROFT- SCOTT STATES THAT MR CROFT’S PERMIT WAS REVOKED BASED ON A 2015 IMPARED DRIVING CONVICTION. MR CROFT THEN STATES THAT THE LETTER HE RECEIVED INDICATED THAT HIS PERMIT WAS REVOKED BASED ON AN ALCOHOL RELATED CONVICTION. LATTER HE RECEIVED ANOTHER LETTER REFERENCING THE REVOCATION WAS BASED ON A DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF METABOLITE/DRUG CONVICTION. INFORMS BOARD THAT THE SECOND LETTER IS THE CORRECT OFFENCE. MR CROFT THEN STATES THAT HE WAS FEELING UNDER THE WEATHER, CAME HOME FROM WORK AND TOOK COLD MEDICINE ON TOP OF A PERSCRIBED SLEEPING PILL. DOES NOT RECALL HOW HE ENDED UP AT THE 7-11, AND WITH THE CHARGES. DOES NOT TAKE THE MEDICATION AN LONGER, HAS NOT SINCE THE INCIDENT OCCURRED. APPEARED BEFORE THE JUDGE. CLAIMS THAT THE JUDGE WOULD JUST THROW THE CASE OUT IF IT WERE UP TO HIM. BUT HAD TO FOLLOW THE LAW. MR CROFT THEN INFORMS THE BOARD THAT HE PAID ALL FINES, WENT THOUGH A LIFE COURSE WHICH HE COMPLETED. MOTION TO UPHOLD THE STATE MIKE, CHRIS SECONDS. CLARK WITH A VOTE OF NAY. UPHELD.

MICHAEL STAHLE - SCOTT STATES THAT MR STAHLE’S PERMIT WAS REVOKED BASED ON 2014 IMPAIRED DRIVING CONVICTION. MR STAHLE THEN STATES THAT HE HAD TAKEN THE DRUG CHANTIX TO HELP HIM QUIT SMOKING. THOUGHT HE HAD A DOCTOR APP ON 10 DEC, BUT IT WAS ACTUALL ON THE 07 DEC. INFORMS BOARD THAT THE SOME OF THE DRUGS SIDE AFFECTS INCLUDE LOSS OF TIME. WAS PULLED OVER FOR CROSSING THE CENTER LINE ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS. WAS GIVEN A FST. CLAIMS HE NO LONGER TAKES THIS MEDICATION. MOTIN TO UHOLD THE STATE CHRIS, ERIC SECONDS. UNANIMOUS. UPHELD.

JC RAMIREZ- SCOTT STATES THAT MR RAMIREZ'S PERMIT WAS SUSPENDED BASED ON A 2014 INTOXICATION CONVICTION. MR RAMIREZ THEN STATES HE WAS NOT DRIVING AT THE TIME. INFORMS BOARD THAT HE WAS AT HIS RESIDENTS HOSTING A PARTY FOR HIS SON. HAD SEVERAL BEERS THROUGHOUT THE DAY, WATCHED A MOVIE THEN CRASHED. AROUND 1 IN THE MORNING MR RAMIREZ CLAIMS THAT THE ALARM ON HIS HOME HAD GONE OFF. NOT SURE WHAT WAS GOING ON, HE GRABED HIS FIREARM, WHICH HE KEEPS UNDER HIS PILLOW AND WENT TO INVESTIGATE. INFORMS BOARD THAT HE SAW SOMEONE RUNNING FROM HIS DEN TO THE FRONT DOOR, FIRED A SHOT IN THAT DIRECTION. BECAUSE OF THE ALARM, THE POLICE ARRIVED AT HIS HOME. MR RAMIREZ THEN STATES THAT THE OFFICER SHOT HIM TWICE THROUGH HIS FRONT DOOR. NICK MOTIONS TO CLOSE SESSION, CLARK SECONDS. MOTION TO REOPEN SESSION. POLICE REPORT HAS BEEN OBTAINED. BOARD MEMBERS REVIEW POLICE REPORT. MOTION TO UPHOLD THE STATE CHRIS, CLARK SECONDS. UNANIMOUS. UPHELD.

MARLENE FAHNESTOCK-JEFF STATES THAT MS FAHNESTOCK'S PERMIT WAS DENIED BASED ON A 2011 UNLAWFUL FOR MINOR TO CONSUME ALCOHOLIC PRODUCT AND ALCOHOL RESTRICTED DRIVER'S LICENSE CONVICTION. MS FAHNESTOCK THEN STATES THAT BOTH CHARGES WERE WHEN SHE WAS YOUNGER, NOT MATURE. THIS IS THE ONLY INCIDENT ON HER RECORD. INFORMS BOARD THAT SHE IS AN UPSTANDING CITIZEN. WOULD LIKE THE PERMIT TO PROTECT HERSELF WHILE RUNNING ECT. MOTION TO UPHOLD THE STATE NICK, WOULD LIKE THE 1 YEAR REMOVED, AND ISSUED THE PERMIT, ERIC SECONDS. UNANIMOUS. OVERTURNED.

STEPHEN THOMPSON- NICK STATES THAT MR THOMPSON'S PERMIT WAS DENIED BASED ON A NICS HIT MENTAL DEFECTIVE/COMMITTED TO MENTAL INSTITUTION. MR THOMPSON THEN STATES THAT HE FEELS LIKE HE IS DEAD IN THE WATER. HAS DOCUMENTS TO PROVE THAT HE HAS BEEN PARDONED AS WELL AS INFO ON HIS MENTAL STATUS. BOARD THEN INFORMS MR THOMPSON THAT THERE IS NOTHING THEY CAN DO BECAUSE HE IS DENIED ON A FEDERAL LEVEL. MR THOMPSON WAS THEN INFORMED BY THE BOARD THAT HE COULD APPLY TO BE IN THE APPEALS FILE. MOTION TO UPHOLD THE STATE NICK, CLARK SECONDS. UNANIMOUS. UPHELD.

STEVEN WELCH- SCOTT STATES THAT MR WELCH'S PERMIT WAS REVOKED BASED ON FAILURE TO PROVIDE AN FBI FINGERPRINT CARD UPON REQUEST. MR WELCH THEN STATES THAT HE IS AN OVER THE ROAD TRUCK DRIVER AND IS RARELY HOME. UPON RETURNING HOME HE RECEIVED THE REVOCATION NOTICE. CLAIMS THAT HE NEVER RECEIVED THE SUSPENSION NOTICE. NICK

MOTIONS TO OVERTURN THE STATE IF NEW SET OF FPC ARE SUBMITTED, CLARKS SECONDS. UNANIMOUS. OVERTURNED.

MATHEW NIKOLAS- NICK STATES THAT MR NIKOLAS'S PERMIT WAS DENIED BASED ON 2001 FELONY CONVICTION OF 07361 VUCSA-POSSESS WITHOUT A PRESCRIPTION. MR NIKOLAS THEN STATES THAT HE WAS IN POSSESSION OF METH. HE HAS SINCE REMOVED HIMSELF FROM THAT LIFESTYLE. IN THE STATE OF UTAH HIS CONVICTION WOULD BE A CLASS A MISD. BOARD INFORMS MR NIKOLAS OF THAT. MR NICKOLAS STATES THAT HE MADE A MISTAKE, HAS LEARNED FROM IT. HAS HAD NO OTHER PROBLEMS SINCE. SERVED 2 DAYS IN JAIL, PAID ALL FINES AND COMPLETED PROBATION. MOTION TO OVERTURN ERIC, CLARK SECONDS. CHRIS NAY. OVERTURNED.
