2.1 Discuss/Approve/Deny Solid Waste and Recycling Request for Proposal

There were a few typographical errors mentioned. The City Council questioned if they needed to mandate that Fruit Heights waste be taken to Wasatch Integrated Waste. He requested that the proposal mention that all solid waste picked up by that hauler. It was requested that it be mentioned in the background paragraph that the City of Fruit Heights will be recycling through Wasatch Integrated Waste District and the new MuRF system.
