

PROJECTS

Information from Engineering Department

2700 West Wall



Construction of the new wall along the west side of 2700 West Road South of 4700 South is complete. The project replaced the existing variety of fencing with a 6' stamped concrete sound wall. Staining of the new fence (see below photo for Taylorsville typical color) and final landscaping is scheduled for spring time and will be completed as weather allows.

Bowling Avenue Wall

This project will install a precast concrete decorative wall between the Salt Lake Community College campus and a section of the residents along Bowling Avenue (project extent may be modified). The existing variety of fencing will be replaced with a 10' stamped concrete wall (Taylorsville typical style). The open house held for the residents last week was well attended. Construction of this new wall along the south side of Community Blvd. is scheduled for construction after May 5th to correspond with the end of semester at the college.

The city obtained complete funding through the State of Utah and the Salt Lake Community College.

ELECTRONIC PLAN REVIEW

Information from Building Department

On March 15, 2016, the City of Taylorsville's Building Department will transition to an electronic plan review format for all building permit applications. Instead of bringing building plans to the city offices, plans will now be submitted electronically to the city's plan review website: <http://taylorsville.eprocess360.com/login>

Here you will be able to check the status of plans, schedule inspections, and manage your building permit. This website will simplify the permit application process and allow users to

inquire about the status any time of day. The building department is available to offer first-time users assistance with website use and set up to scan and upload their plans. This change will streamline the overall process and assist in keeping permit costs as low as possible.

WINTER PARKING REMINDER

11.20.080: Parking Prohibited When:

It is unlawful for any person who owns or has possession, custody or control of any vehicle to park any vehicle on any street or highway:

- A. After any snow and/or ice accumulation, until after the street or highway is cleared of snow and/or ice; or
- B. For a period longer than twenty four (24) hours; or
- C. For any period longer than the allowed by appropriate signs, markings or parking meters giving notice of such parking time limitation. (Ord. 14-03, 2-19-2014)

What can't go in the green can?

- 1. Oils of any kind; vegetables oils, seed oils like canola, sunflower, flax, or castor bean.
- 2. Meats of any kind; skins, tendons, (meat) table leftovers, BBQ leftovers, and spoiled meats.
- 3. Fats, grease, paper; any paper products, lubricating grease, cooking grease, grease based cleaners, and fats.

4. Decomposable cutlery and wares; plates, cutlery, diapers, anything corn-based, vegetable oil based, TaterWare, WheatWare, or wheat-straw based Bio-degradable bags.

5. Inorganics; rocks, dirt, vermiculite, or sod.

Raccoon cages are available to rent at West Valley City Animal Shelter.

Shelter hours are Monday through Friday from 9:30 a.m. – 7:00 p.m., and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. The shelter is located at 4522 West 3500 South in West Valley City.

Vaccination clinics are held at the West Valley City Animal Shelter on the second and fourth Tuesday of every month. Clinics run from 3 to 5:30 p.m. on a first come first served basis, and will close early if full. All vaccinations are \$10 each for West Valley City and Taylorville Residents; \$15 each for non-residents.

Cats: Rabies, FVRCP, FELV/VIP
