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Davis County Regulation *Overview*

- Originally passed Regulation in February 2014
 - Updated in November 2014
- Legislature passed HB 415 which lead to the Utah Electronic Cigarette Substance Standards Rule (R384-415)
 - Updated Davis County Regulation in anticipation of changes
 - Issues

Proposed Changes

- Formally adopting the State Rule
- Renaming “Electronic Cigarette Product Regulation”
- Matching Definitions in Rule:
 - Electronic Smoking Device (ESD) changed to Electronic Cigarette Product
 - E-Liquid changed to Electronic Cigarette Substance
 - E-Liquid Components changed to Electronic Cigarette Substance Components
- Eliminating specific labeling, nicotine level, and component quality requirements
