

Pooled Services - Violent Crimes Unit

The Violent Crimes Unit investigated the following in Taylorsville:

- 11 Deaths
- 2 attempted suicides
- 5 assaults (these are just ones that were assigned for more follow up by a detective, it doesn't include what patrol handled)
- 2 Robberies

Significant Cases:

- On December 16, 2015 Luis Rodriguez, was detained for shoplifting at the Wal-Mart, located at 5469 South Redwood Rd in Taylorsville. While being -detained in the Loss Prevention office, Rodriguez threatened the Wal-Mart employees with a gun, and then fled. Rodriguez ran east through the Wal-Mart parking lot, and up to a wall on the far east end. Rodriguez fired one round, and then fled over the wall. Rodriguez was not located at the time, and aggravated robbery charges have since been filed.

Taylorsville - Investigations Unit

- On 10/07/2015, Detective Bennett and Taylorsville Investigations Unit assisted Utah County Major Crimes Unit in locating and apprehending an Orem homicide suspect in the Millcreek area.
- On 10/07/2015, Detective Jaren Fowler and Taylorsville Precinct Investigations Unit detectives in concert with UCMC obtained and served a drug search warrant in Sandy, Utah. Detectives located and seized one pound of heroin and one ounce of cocaine. One male was booked into jail.
- On 10/07/2015, Detective Bennett and Taylorsville Precinct Investigations Unit detectives assisted by UCMC obtained and served a drug search warrant in the Kearns area. Detectives located and seized 5 ounces of heroin, 5 ounces of methamphetamine, and \$2035.
- On 10/08/2015, Detective Lovendahl arrived on a report of a suspicious and determined that it was an occupied stolen vehicle. The three occupants were apprehended without incident.
- On 10/16/15, Detective Lovendahl served a no-knock search warrant at a residence on a nuisance house in Taylorsville. Detectives located and seized small amounts of heroin and methamphetamine. The SLCO Health Department closed the residence to occupancy. One adult male was booked into jail.
- On 10/16/15, Detective Lovendahl served a knock and announce search warrant at a WVC residence. Detectives located and seized 6.6 lbs of high-grade marijuana and \$16,840 in cash. One male adult was booked into jail.
- On 10/16/15, Detective Lovendahl served a no-knock search warrant at a residence on a nuisance house in Taylorsville. Detectives located and seized small amounts of heroin and methamphetamine. The SLCO Health Department closed the residence to occupancy. One adult male was booked into jail.

Taylorsville - Investigations Unit

- On 10/16/15, Detective Lovendahl served a knock and announce search warrant at a WVC residence. Detectives located and seized 6.6 lbs of high-grade marijuana and \$16,840 in cash. One male adult was booked into jail.
- On 10/16/15, Detectives Fowler and Bennett located an occupied stolen vehicle. An apprehension plan was developed and detectives converged on the car when a female got into the driver's seat. She was taken into custody without incident.
- On 10/27/15, Detective Lovendahl located a suspicious vehicle in Taylorsville. She witnessed a drug exchange and arrested four adults. She located and seized 170 balloons of heroin (27 grams), 46 balloons of cocaine (8 grams), \$527 cash, and a Chevrolet Cobalt.
- On 10/27/15, Detective Bennett received information that a fugitive was at Valley Regional Park and was in possession of a large amount of drugs. Detectives located the fugitive and he was arrested for his warrants. Detectives located and seized over 1 pound of methamphetamine, 17 grams of heroin, and \$3,073 cash. Detective Bennett obtained and served a search warrant for the suspect's motel room. Additional drug paraphernalia was located there.
- On 10/28/15, Detective Valencia located a wanted fugitive inside the Taylorsville Applebee's restaurant and arrested him. Drugs were observed inside of the suspect's vehicle. Detective Bennett obtained a search warrant for the vehicle. Detectives located and seized 13 bottles of synthetic cannabinoid (spice), and 17 small baggies of methamphetamine.
- On 10/29/15, Detective Bennett placed a tracking device on a recently stolen vehicle. An hour later, the vehicle went mobile. A tire deflation device was deployed to prevent the vehicle from fleeing. A high hazard traffic stop was conducted and the driver was arrested.

- On 10/29/15, Detective Bennett received information from Sgt. Morton regarding possible drug activity. Detective Bennett obtained and served a search warrant at a motel room in Midvale. Detectives located and seized 2 grams of heroin, drug paraphernalia, and shaved keys.
- On 11/3/15, Detective Bennett received information that an adult male fugitive driving a stolen vehicle was at the Days Inn in Midvale. An arrest plan was developed and the suspect was arrested.
- On 11/4/15, as part of an ongoing investigation, Detective Neal received information that an adult female fugitive was at an address in Taylorsville. She was located and booked into jail.
- On 11/4/15, Detective Fowler located an occupied stolen vehicle. He was able to follow it from a distance. The driver noticed Detective Fowler and began to actively elude him. A Kearns patrol officer located the vehicle in a driveway. A high hazard stop was conducted and the driver was arrested. He also had several outstanding felony warrants. He was booked into jail.
- On 11/5/15, as part of an ongoing investigation, Detective Neal located an armed and dangerous fugitive at an address in SLC. He was arrested and was in possession of 1 gram of methamphetamine.
- On 11/6/15, Taylorsville SCU and MGU detectives assisted Sgt. Morton with the arrest of a female wanted in connection with a recent home invasion robbery and pursuit in Midvale. MGU obtained a search warrant and drug paraphernalia was located in her hotel room.
